Her Royal Highness wil be accompanied by:

British Ambassador and Lady Wright Lord Napier and Ettrick Lady Anne Tennant and Mr. Tennant

THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN escort Her Royal Highness to the Yellow Oval Room via the Grand Staircase.

8:15 p.m. Guests are led out of the Yellow Oval Room and into the Family Dining Room to be seated for dinner.

Dinner is served.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 1, 1983

The equipment for Mr. Hamlish's performance is installed in the Yellow Oval Room and chairs are set up auditorium style. Doors to the Yellow Oval Room are closed.

- 9:30 p.m. Dinner concludes, and guests are led from the Family Dining Room into the Hall for coffee, liqueurs, and then champagne.
- 9:40 p.m. Guests are led by MRS. REAGAN from the Hall into the Yellow Oval Room to be seated for performance.

9:45 p.m. Mr. Marvin Hamlisch begins his performance.

10:15 p.m. Performance concludes.

THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN thank Mr. Hamlisch.

(Remarks)

10:20 p.m. THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN escort Her Royal Highness to the Grand Foyer via the Grand Staircase and bid farewell.

Remainder of guests follow.

THE PRESIDENT and MRS. REAGAN bid farewell to the remainder of the guests and then return to the Residence.
