Note: Since no remarks are required, what is provided as background information is for your personal information only.

- -- Mr. Mervin Amerine is formerly of the Amerine Turkey Breeding
 Farms which were located in Oakdale, California. During your
 campaign for Governor of California, Mr. Amerine provided his
 company's DC-3 airplane for your use. This DC-3 was informally
 known as the "Turkey Bird." On several occasions during your
 gubernatorial campaign, Mr. Amerine's wife, Nancy Amerine,
 served as a stewardess on the "Turkey Bird" and remembers those
 occasions very well.
- -- You addressed the National Turkey Federation convention in San Diego, California in 1979 (Town and Country Hotel).
