

#### I. PURPOSE

The Cabinet Council on Commerce and Trade is meeting to review with you NASA's proposal to begin research and development of a manned space station.

#### II. BACKGROUND

Following your decisions concerning a National Space Policy, the Senior Interagency Group on Space (SIG/SPACE) chaired by your Assistant for National Security Affairs considered alternative approaches to a U.S. space station.

A presentation of four options developed as a result of the work by SIG/SPACE will be made during the meeting. The recommendations are summarized below and discussed in the attached materials from SIG/SPACE.

#### Options:

- 1. Approve NASA's recommendation to begin research and development of a U.S. manned space station.
- 2. Direct NASA to pursue a program utilizing unmanned platforms in space and a newly developed extended duration space shuttle/orbiter.
- 3. Direct further study of this matter and do not approve either approach listed above.
- 4. Direct that research and development be undertaken on both a manned space station and unmanned platforms serviced by extended duration space shuttle orbiters. (Options 1 and 2)
