- Presidential event in Roosevelt Room on Tuesday announcing the sending of the bill on Tuition Tax Credits to the Hill.

RED FLAGS

- Unprepared Congressional sponsorship for tuition tax credit bill sent shock waves through the solid coalition for this bill. Many major groups are unlikely now to spend significant resources unless and until the President personally goes public urging passage of this bill this year.
- Normally Reagan supportive veterans groups getting more militant against Administrator Nimmo at VA.
- National Right to Work Committee burning up the wires and preparing to flood the mails with attacks on Solicitor General Rex Lee over the issue of right to work in federal enclaves in right to work states.
- Conservative groups likely to oppose any Administration package for tax increases

MISCELLANEOUS

- Southern Baptist endorsement of voluntary school prayer amendment has caused many reporters as well as religious leaders to rethink the chances of passage of the President's proposed voluntary school prayer amendment.
