Enclosed is our new financial syllabus, "Satonomics to Godonomics", that we use when giving financial seminars. I am tired of the news media and short-minded people coming against Reaganomics. If they would listen to what is really being said and not run with the fear of losing their own little world, the nation and they would begin to flourish. Some reports after having taught this seminar are: In the black ghetto of San Diego, a group of black brothers are now committed to each other to begin producing and becoming debt free with proper managment.
