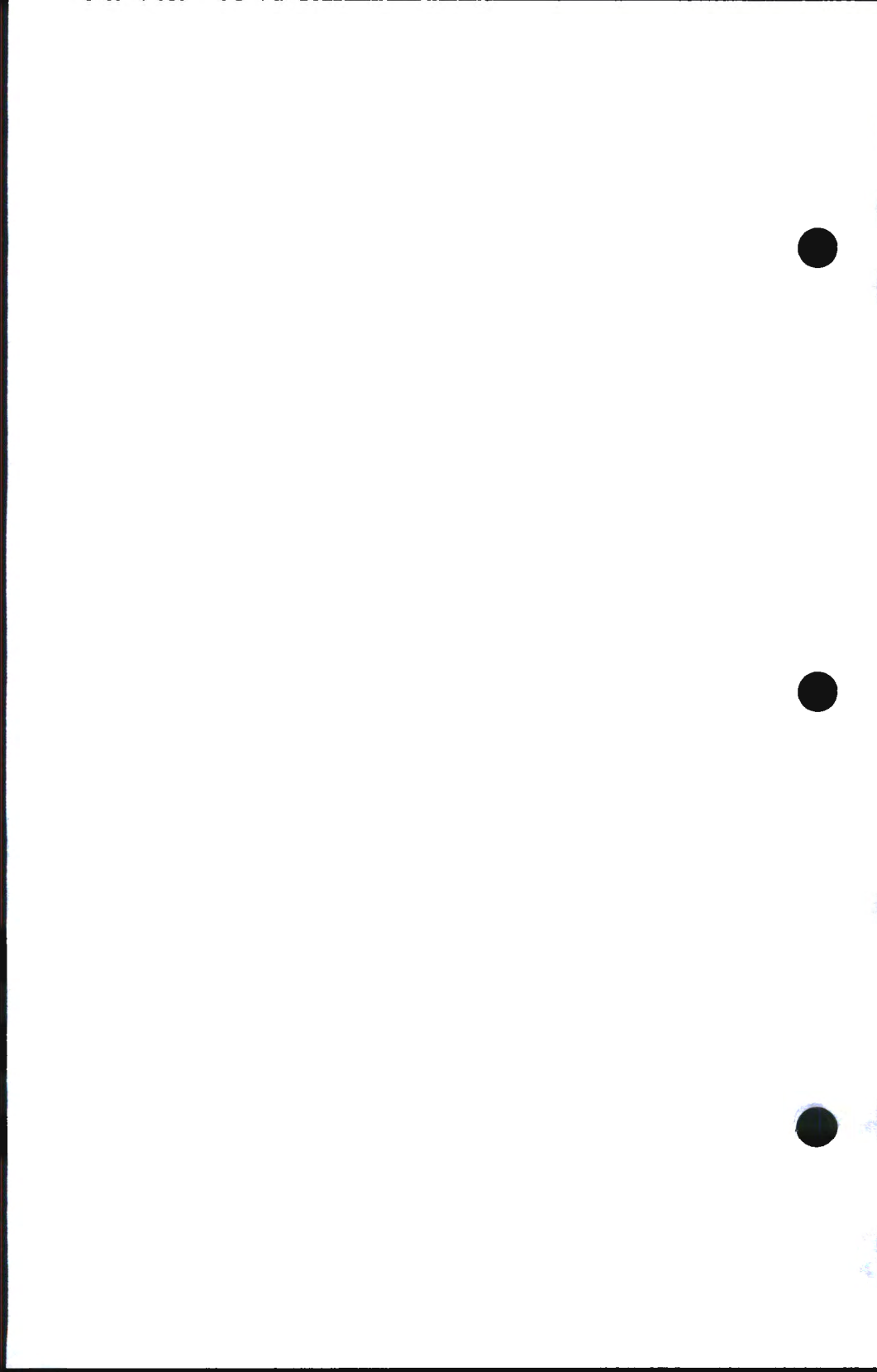

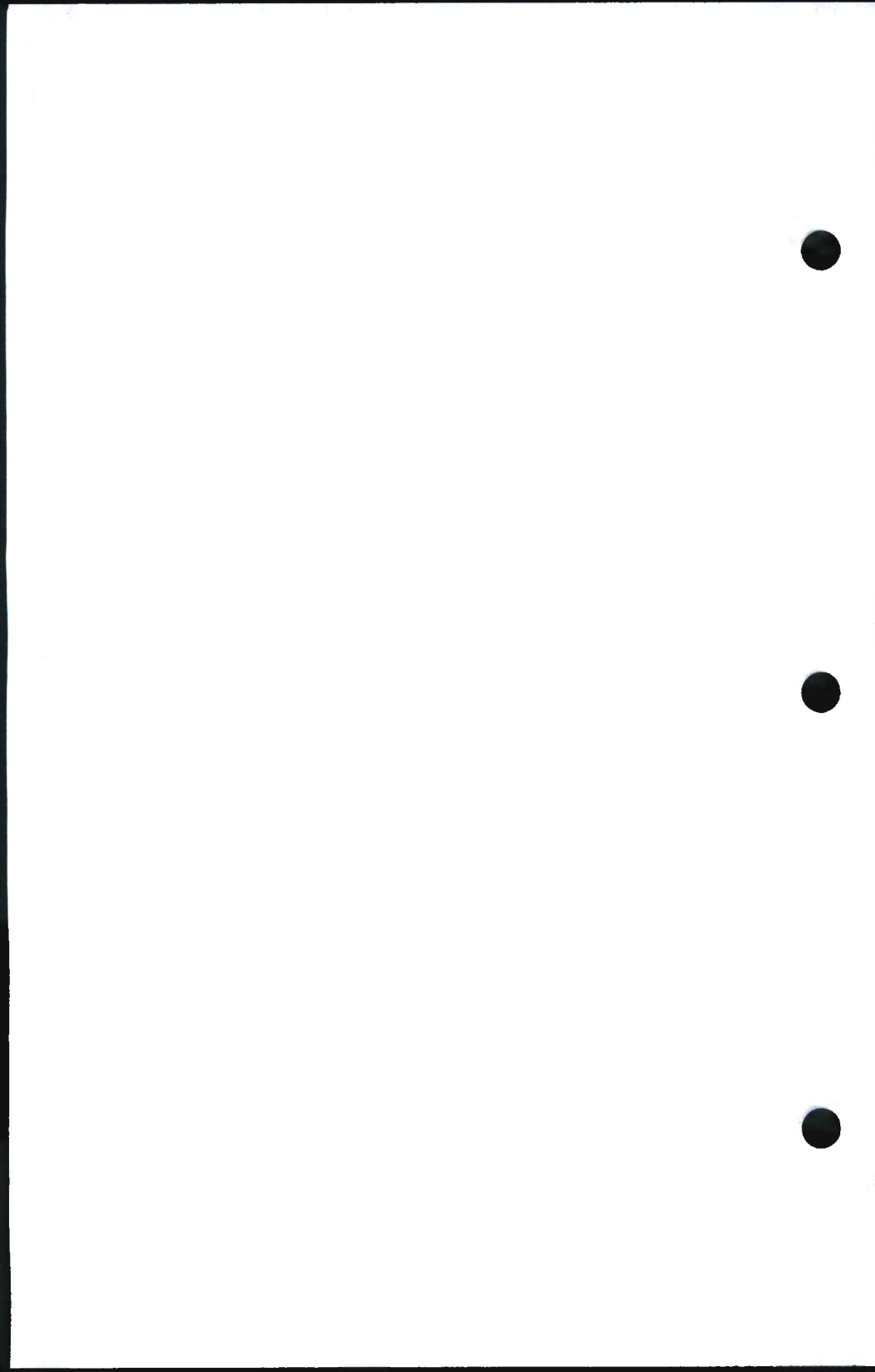

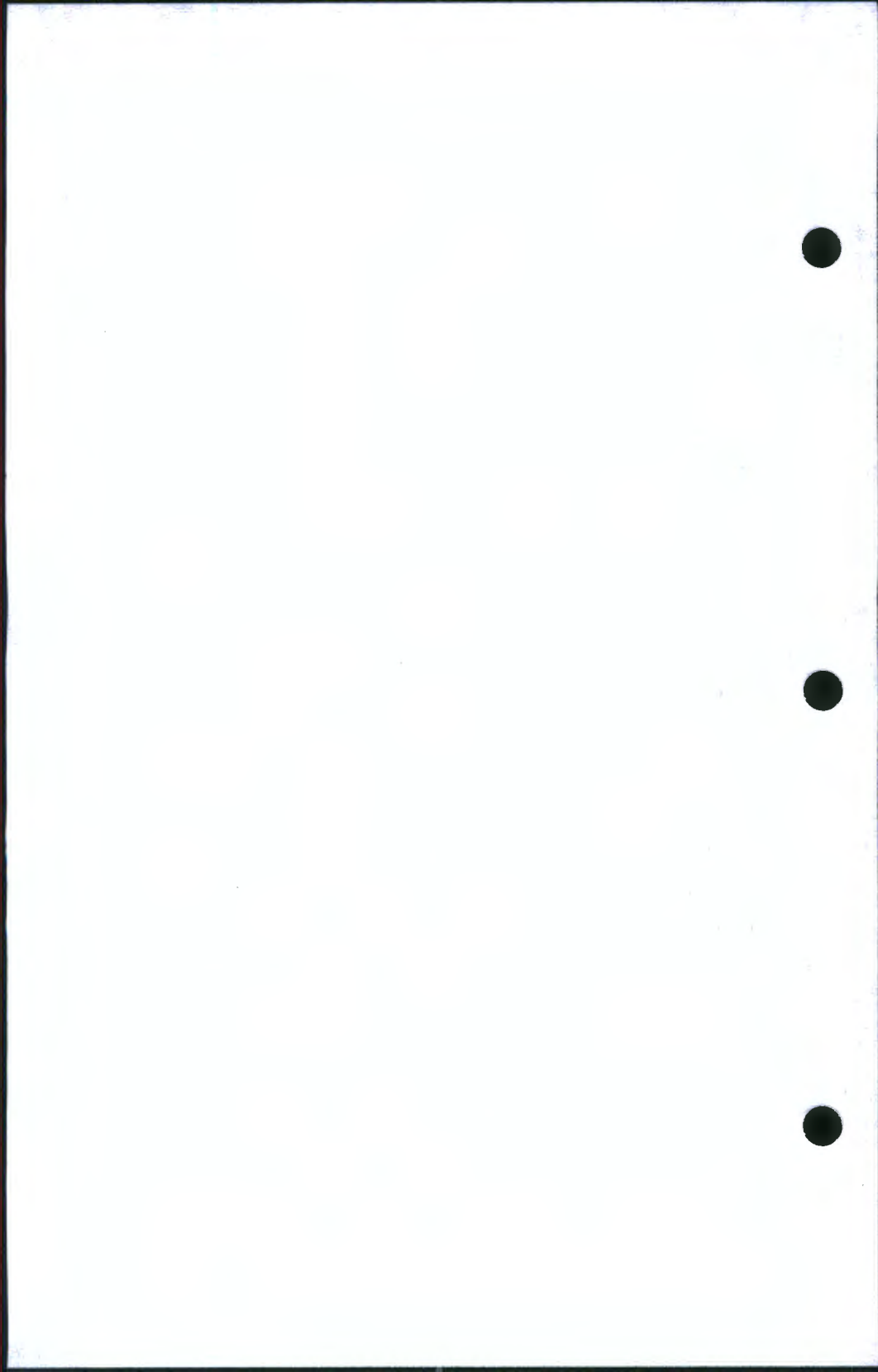

BY - LAWS

ENLISTED ASSOCIATION OF THE
NATIONAL GUARD OF THE UNITED STATES

13 September 1979

ARTICLE I

The name of this Association is "Enlisted Association of the National Guard of the United States," hereinafter referred to as the "ASSOCIATION."

ARTICLE II

The object of the ASSOCIATION is to promote and maintain adequate national security and to promote and advance the status, welfare and professionalism of the enlisted members of the National Guard of the United States.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Classes of Membership in the ASSOCIATION are:

- a. Annual
- b. Life
- c. Honorary
- d. Associate

Section 2. Qualifications and Requirements for the Several Classes are:

a. Annual: Annual membership will be contingent upon current membership in a state association chartered to this ASSOCIATION, except that in states where there is no state organization chartered to this ASSOCIATION, members may join as individuals in an "at-large" status. Upon application and payment of the prescribed annual dues, an annual membership may be issued to an enlisted member, active or retired, of the National Guard as follows:

(1) Associations consisting solely of enlisted personnel, shall, upon application be chartered as a member organization of the ASSOCIATION with representation based upon the total membership.

(2) Associations consisting of both officers and enlisted personnel, shall, upon application, be chartered for the enlisted portion of the organization as a member of the organization of the ASSOCIATION with representation based on its enlisted membership only.

(3) Members in an "at-large" status, will be entitled to no representation other than through the Area Director for their respective area, until such a time that a charter is granted to the state of residence of these members, except that these members "at-large" shall be entitled to a voice on the floor under the same circumstances that all other Annual members are.

1 b. Life: Upon application, payment of the prescribed amount and approval
2 of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION, a person who is qualified to
3 be an Annual member may be issued a Life membership. Life membership will
4 be retained by those individuals who receive warrants or commissions as
5 officers, except that these individuals may not vote or hold office.

6 c. Honorary: The Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION may, by majority
7 vote, confer Honorary membership upon a person who has rendered outstand-
8 ing service to the United States, any political subdivision thereof, and
9 the National Guard of the United States. An honorary member may not be
10 an accredited state delegate, hold office or be entitled to vote.

11 d. Associate: Upon application, payment of prescribed dues and approval
12 of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION, a person not otherwise qual-
13 ified for membership may be issued an Associate membership. An Associate
14 member may not be an accredited state delegate, hold office or be entitled
15 to vote.

16 Section 3. Dues:

17 a. The dues required for membership in the ASSOCIATION are:

18 (1) Annual - \$1.00 (Effective 1Jul80 - \$2.00)

19 (2) Life - Life membership shall be made available to those members
20 who shall so elect. The fee shall be \$10.00 at age 60 or over. If
21 under age 60, the fee shall be \$10.00 plus the regular annual dues
22 for each year the member is under age 60.

23 (3) Honorary - None

24 (4) Associate - \$3.00 per year.

25 b. Annual and Associate dues are due and payable on or before July 1
26 of each year.

27 c. An Annual or Associate membership is effective from July 1 or date
28 of receipt of the dues at the headquarters of the ASSOCIATION, whichever
29 is later.

30 Section 4. Membership Termination:

31 a. Termination of state chartered organizations may be approved effective
32 with the close of the fiscal year:

33 (1) Upon approval by 2/3 vote of the Executive Council.

34 (2) Upon written notification by the state organization.

35 b. The Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION may by 2/3 vote, and the
36 return of any current dues:

1 (1) Reject any application for membership; or

2 (2) After extending to the member concerned a reasonable opportunity
3 to present evidence in their behalf, terminate a membership.

4 ARTICLE IV

5 OFFICERS

6 Section 1. Titles: The Officers of the ASSOCIATION are:

- 7 a. President
8 b. Vice-President
9 c. The Immediate-Past-President
10 d. Secretary
11 e. Treasurer
12 f. Area Directors

13 Section 2. Duties and Powers:

14 a. President:

15 (1) A member ex-officio of all committees except the Committee on
16 Nominations.

17 (2) The President shall:

18 (a) Direct the affairs of the ASSOCIATION in accordance with the
19 policies adopted in General or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION.

20 (b) Appoint all committees and designate the Chairman and Vice
21 Chairman of each except the Committee on Nominations.

22 (c) Appoint the Area Chairmen, subject to the approval of the
23 Executive Council.

24 (d) Designate a Chairman of each caucus required to be convened
25 pursuant to Article X, Section 3, Sub-section b, Paragraph (1)
26 of the By-Laws of the ASSOCIATION.

27 (e) Issue a call for a General Conference and, when directed to
28 do so by the Executive Council, issue the call for a Special Conf-
29 erence of the ASSOCIATION and make the necessary arrangements for
30 such conferences.

31 (f) With the approval of the Executive Council, direct the
32 operation of the employees and headquarters offices of the
33 ASSOCIATION.

34 (g) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

(h) Perform such other duties as are usually performed by the President of an organization and as may be prescribed by the By-Laws or assigned by the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION.

b. Vice-President: The Vice-President is a member of the Executive Council and shall:

(1) Perform the duties usually performed by the Vice-President of an organization and such duties as may be prescribed by the By-Laws or assigned by the President of the ASSOCIATION.

(2) Assume the office, title and pre-requisites of the President in the event of the termination, resignation or removal from office of that officer and serve the unexpired portion of tenure in office.

c. Immediate-Past-President: The Immediate-Past-President is a member of the Executive Council. Unless elected thereto under procedures prescribed in the By-Laws of the ASSOCIATION, the Immediate-Past-President may not succeed to any other office by reason of absence, incapacity, death, resignation, or removal from office of such other officer.

d. Secretary: The Secretary is:

(1) The recording officer of the organization.

(2) Responsible for the records of the ASSOCIATION.

(3) A member of the Executive Council.

e. Treasurer: The Treasurer is a member of the Executive Council and shall perform the duties usually performed by the Treasurer of an organization and such other duties as may be prescribed by the By-Laws or assigned by the President of the ASSOCIATION.

f. Area Directors: Area Directors are members of the Executive Council and shall:

(1) Provide liaison between the ASSOCIATION and the states in their respective area.

(2) Visit state associations as a representative of the ASSOCIATION.

(3) Provide information/advice on ASSOCIATION matters to states upon request.

Section 3. Election:

The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the ASSOCIATION shall be elected biennially, by majority vote, by a General Conference of the ASSOCIATION. In the event that a nominee for an office of the ASSOCIATION fails to receive a majority, the succeeding votes shall be taken on the two nominees who received the highest number on the first vote.

1 Section 4. Tenure:

2 a. The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the ASSOCIATION
3 shall be installed in office on the last day of the General Conference by
4 which they are elected.

5 b. The Immediate-Past-President of the ASSOCIATION shall be installed in
6 office on the day the successor in the office of President is qualified
7 and installed in that office.

8 Section 5. Termination of Tenure:

9 An officer may be removed from office by a 2/3 vote of the Executive
10 Council for sufficient cause.

11 Section 6. Nomination of Officers:

12 The Committee on Nominations consists of a chairman appointed by the
13 Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION, and one delegate from each state,
14 designated by the President of the respective states thereof; to serve
15 during a General Conference or until discharged by the Conference. The
16 Committee on Nominations shall:

17 (1) Convene on the first day of a General Conference which is
18 required to elect officers of the ASSOCIATION.

19 (2) Prepare a slate of nominations consisting of the names of
20 eligible members of the ASSOCIATION for each office required to be
21 filled by the General Conference.

22 (3) Prepare a slate of nominations for any vacancies on the Executive
23 Council required to be filled by the members of the ASSOCIATION referred
24 to it by the appropriate National Guard Area Caucus convened for that
25 purpose.

26 ARTICLE V

27 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

28 Section 1. Duties and Responsibilities:

29 a. Act as an aid and advisor to the President.

30 b. Be an official representative of the ASSOCIATION in dealing with other
31 organizations and/or businesses.

32 c. Perform such other duties as are usually performed by the Executive
33 Director of an organization and as may be prescribed by the By-Laws or
34 assigned by the President of the ASSOCIATION.

1 Section 2. Selection:

2 The Executive Director shall be appointed by the Executive Council through
3 the competitive process from applicants of the ASSOCIATION'S membership.

4 Section 3. Salary:

5 The salary for this position will be established annually by the Executive
6 Council.

7 ARTICLE VI

8 CONFERENCES

9 Section 1. General Conferences:

10 A General Conference of the ASSOCIATION shall be convened annually.

11 Section 2. Special Conferences:

12 A Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION may be convened when required.

13 Section 3. Representation:

14 a. Representation at a General Conference of Special Conference of the
15 ASSOCIATION is by state. For this purpose, the number of state delegates
16 apportioned to and accredited annually by each state is:

17 (1) Associations consisting solely of enlisted personnel shall be
18 entitled to one delegate representing the state who shall be the
19 President of the state organization, or in the event the President is
20 unable to attend the Conference, an alternate designated by the
21 President.

22 (2) Associations consisting of both officers and enlisted personnel
23 shall be entitled to one delegate representing the state who shall be
24 the President of the state organization; provided he is an enlisted
25 member. An enlisted member shall serve as a delegate in the event
26 the President of the state organization is a commissioned officer.

27 (3) One additional delegate for each 200 active enlisted members,
28 or major fraction thereof, of the ASSOCIATION of the state, based
29 upon the actual members as of the thirtieth (30th) day of the month
30 of June preceding the Conference each year. Notice thereof to the
31 National Treasurer so as to establish the actual voting strength of
32 a given state for the National Conference of the year.

33 b. The accredited state delegates and the officers of the ASSOCIATION
34 as prescribed in Article IV, Section 1 shall comprise the voting body
35 of a General Conference of Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION.

c. In the event of a partial of complete mobilization into active Federal Service of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard or both of them for a period extending beyond the 30th day of June last preceding a General Conference of the ASSOCIATION, representation at such Conference shall be apportioned on the basis of actual active membership of the association of each state as of the 30th day of June last preceding the date of the initial order or call of units into active Federal Service under the mobilization.

Section 4. Quorum:

At a General or Special Conference, State Caucus, National Guard Caucus, Executive Council Meeting, or Committee Meeting of this ASSOCIATION, a quorum for the purpose of transacting business shall be constituted by those present provided sufficient notice has been provided as required by these By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

Section 1. The Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION Consists of:

a. The Officers of the ASSOCIATION.

b. Two Army and two Air National Guard Area Directors of the ASSOCIATION from each National Guard Area.

Section 2. Duties and Powers:

The Executive Council shall:

(1) Have general supervision of the affairs of the ASSOCIATION between General Conference.

(2) In the event of a vacancy on the Executive Council resulting from termination of tenure, or the assumption of the office of President by the Vice-President, elect, by majority vote, a successor to the vacant office to serve the unexpired period of tenure.

(3) Appoint the Chairman of the Committee on Nominations.

(4) Convene:

(a) At the call of the President of the ASSOCIATION.

(b) Upon written demand signed by a majority of the members thereof, and communicated to each member of the Executive Council.

Section 3. Election:

a. Officers of the ASSOCIATION, other than the Immediate-Past-President, are members of the Executive Council by virtue of election to an office of the ASSOCIATION.

b. Army and Air National Guard Area Directors of the Executive Council representing National Guard Areas, respectively, are elected at a General Conference of the ASSOCIATION by an Area Caucus. Two nominees shall be elected each year from each National Guard Area.

c. In the event there are more nominees than there are vacancies to be filled on the Executive Council from a National Guard Area, the nominee receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared elected.

Section 4. Tenure:

a. Members of the Executive Council shall be installed on the last day of the General Conference by which they were elected to the Executive Council.

b. Unless terminated or removed therefrom as provided in these By-Laws, members of the Executive Council shall serve as such members for a term of two (2) years, except as provided in Section 2, Paragraph (1) of this Article

ARTICLE VIII

COMMITTEES

Section 1. Standing Committees of the ASSOCIATION are:

- a. Committee on Legislation
- b. Committee on Finance
- c. Committee on Membership
- d. Committee on Publication
- e. Committee on Public Relations
- f. Committee on Army National Guard
- g. Committee on Air National Guard
- h. Committee on By-Laws
- i. Committee on Continuity
- j. Committee on Ways and Means

Section 2. General Conference and Special Conference Committees:

a. General Conference Committees of the ASSOCIATION are:

- (1) Committee on Credentials and Rules
- (2) Committee on Resolutions
- (3) Committee on Nominations
- (4) Committee on Time and Place
- (5) Committee on Distinguished Guests

b. Special Conference Committees of the ASSOCIATION are:

- (1) Committee on Credentials and Rules
- (2) Committee on Resolutions
- (3) Committee on Distinguished Guests

1 Section 3. Standing Committees:

2 a. Committee on Legislation:

3 The Committee on Legislation consists of that number of members of the
4 ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the President's
5 pleasure. The Committee on Legislation shall:

6 (a) Develop and recommend to the Executive Council the
7 legislative policy of the ASSOCIATION.

8 (b) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

9 b. Committee on Finance:

10 (1) The Committee on Finance consists of seven members of the
11 ASSOCIATION appointed, as hereinafter provided, by the President,
12 by and with the consent of the Executive Council, for a term of two
13 years each and is composed of one member from each of the National
14 Guard areas plus one additional member appointed without regard to
15 service or geographical representation.

16 (2) The terms of the members of the Committee on Finance are to be
17 staggered so that annually at least three members complete their
18 tenure on the committee.

19 (3) The Committee on Finance shall:

20 (a) Review the annual budget of the ASSOCIATION as developed by
21 the President, revise, amend or modify it as desired, and
22 recommend its adoption by the Executive Council.

23 (b) Consider requests for extraordinary or unforeseen expenditures
24 not provided for in the annual approved budget, and, if deemed
25 warranted, recommend to the Executive Council, approval thereof.

26 (c) Examine the annual audit of the records and finances of the
27 ASSOCIATION by a Certified Public Accountant.

28 c. Committee on Membership:

29 The Committee on Membership consists of that number of members of the
30 ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the President's
31 pleasure. The Committee on Membership shall:

32 (a) Recommend actions to the Executive Council that will insure
33 that the membership of the ASSOCIATION is maintained at one
34 hundred percent.

35 (b) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

1 d. Committee on Publications:

2 The Committee on Publications consists of that number of members of
3 the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the President's
4 pleasure. The Committee on Publications shall:

5 (a) Develop and recommend to the Executive Council policies that
6 will promote the general welfare of the official publication.

7 (b) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

8 e. Committee on Public Relations:

9 The Committee on Public Relations consists of that number of members
10 of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the President's
11 pleasure. The Committee on Public Relations shall:

12 (a) Develop and recommend to the Executive Council policies
13 which will establish and maintain good will with members of
14 Congress, officials, departments and agencies of the Federal
15 Government, the State Governments and the public.

16 (b) Study and report the Executive Council and make rec-
17 ommendations to correct publicity or conditions adverse to the
18 ASSOCIATION and its purposes.

19 f. The Committee on Army National Guard:

20 The Committee on Army National Guard consists of that number of
21 members of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at
22 the President's pleasure. The Committee on Army National Guard shall:

23 (a) Advise and recommend to the Executive Council policies
24 which will increase the efficiency and promote the welfare of
25 the Army National Guard.

26 (b) Promote a general understanding between enlisted personnel
27 of the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard.

28 (c) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

29 g. Committee on Air National Guard:

30 The Committee on Air National Guard consists of that number of
31 members of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at
32 the President's pleasure. The Committee on Air National Guard shall:

33 (a) Advise and recommend to the Executive Council policies which
34 will increase the efficiency and promote the welfare of the Air
35 National Guard.

36 (b) Promote a general understanding between enlisted personnel
37 of the Army National Guard and the Air National Guard.

(c) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

h. Committee on By-Laws:

The Committee on By-Laws consists of that number of members of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the President's pleasure. The Committee on By-Laws shall:

(a) Study the By-Laws of the ASSOCIATION with a view to their improvement, draft proposed amendments thereof, submit them to the General or Special Conference for approval or rejection.

(b) Study proposed amendments thereof submitted by a State or a member of the ASSOCIATION with such recommendations concerning the proposed amendments as the committee may see fit.

i. Committee on Continuity:

The Committee on Continuity consists of a Chairman and Vice-Chairman appointed by the President, and one member of the ASSOCIATION from each State chartered in the ASSOCIATION. All members shall serve at the pleasure of the President. The Committee on Continuity shall:

(a) Advise the Executive Council on all matters affecting those members of the ASSOCIATION who are in a separated status.

(b) Promote increased membership activity and interest among persons in a separated status who are eligible for membership in the ASSOCIATION.

j. Committee on Ways and Means:

The Committee on Ways and Means consists of a Chairman and that number of members of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve at the pleasure of the President. The Committee on Ways and Means shall:

(a) Review and study the annual financial audit, the annual and proposed budgets to determine the monetary needs of the ASSOCIATION.

(b) Develop and recommend to the Executive Council the programs that will benefit the financial growth needs of the ASSOCIATION.

(c) Render an annual report to the ASSOCIATION.

Section 4. General Conference and Special Conference Committees:

a. Committee on Credentials and Rules:

The Committee on Credentials and Rules consists of not more than five members of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION appointed by the President to serve during a General or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION or until discharged by the Conference. The Committee on Credentials and Rules shall:

1 (a) Subject to an appeal to the General or Special Conference
2 concerned, rule on the credentials of each delegate to a General
3 or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION.

4 (b) Cause each member of the voting body of a General or Special
5 Conference of the ASSOCIATION to be provided with appropriate
6 identification.

7 (c) Render a report to each General or Special Conference of
8 the ASSOCIATION, consisting of:

9 (1) A list of the members of the voting body.

10 (2) A list of the ex-officio members of the Conference
11 concerned.

12 (3) A recommendation concerning any special rules to be
13 adopted by the Conference concerned.

14 b. Committee on Resolutions:

15 (1) The Committee on Resolutions consists of a Chairman selected by
16 the President of the ASSOCIATION, and one Army and one Air National
17 Guard member from each state chartered in the ASSOCIATION, design-
18 nated by the President of their respective states to serve during a
19 General or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION or until discharged
20 by the Conference.

21 (2) The Committee on Resolutions shall consider each resolution
22 referred thereto and may revise, amend or modify it only to the extent
23 of clarification and not to the extent of change of meaning or content.
24 The Committee shall consider said resolutions provided such resolution(s)
25 is/are submitted in writing to the designated chairperson not less than
26 45 days prior to the convening of a Special or General Conference with
27 the following exceptions:

28 (a) The 45 day requirement may be waived by the President of the
29 ASSOCIATION not less than 45 days prior to the National conference
30 if a state conference occurs within the time frame.

31 (b) Resolutions submitted from the floor of a Conference will be
32 considered with the provision that if accepted, the Resolution
33 Committee has the opportunity and responsibility to determine the
34 specific intent of the resolution from the state submitting the
35 resolution and research the content for clarity and correctness
36 prior to submission to the respective agency to which the resolu-
37 tion is directed.

38 (3) The Chairman of the Committee on Resolutions shall:

39 (a) Appoint the Army National Guard members of the Committee
40 as a Sub-Committee to consider and report on resolutions per-
41 taining to the Army National Guard.

1 (b) Appoint the Air National Guard members of the Committee
2 as a Sub-Committee to consider and report on resolutions per-
3 taining to the Air National Guard.

4 (c) Designate the chairman of each Sub-Committee.

5 (d) Convene the full Committee on Resolutions to:

6 (1) Consider and act on the report of each Sub-Committee.

7 (2) Consider and act on resolutions which pertain to both
8 Army and Air National Guard.

9 (3) Report to the Conference those resolutions which the
10 Committee on Resolutions recommend for adoption.

11 c. Committee on Time and Place:

12 The Committee on Time and Place consists of a Chairman selected by
13 the President of the ASSOCIATION, and one member from each state
14 designated by the President thereof to serve during a General Con-
15 ference or until discharged by the Conference. The Committee on Time
16 and Place shall:

17 (a) Consider only those invitations for the time and place of a
18 succeeding General Conference that have been certified to the Com-
19 mittee by the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION as meeting the
20 criteria established therefor by the Executive Council.

21 (b) From among those invitations submitted to it by the Executive
22 Council report to the Conference its choice in respect to the time
23 and place of any succeeding General Conference.

24 d. Committee on Distinguished Guests:

25 The Committee on Distinguished Guests consists of at least five
26 members at the General or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION
27 appointed by the President to serve during such Conference or until
28 discharged by the Conference. The Committee on Distinguished Guests
29 shall perform such duties as may be assigned to it by the President
30 of the ASSOCIATION.

31 ARTICLE IX

32 PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

33 The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order, Revised, shall govern the
34 ASSOCIATION in all cases to which they are applicable except where modified by:

35 a. The By-Laws of the ASSOCIATION.

36 b. Standing or Special Rules established by a General or Special Conference.

ARTICLE X

VOTING

Section 1. General:

a. Except as otherwise provided by these By-Laws the method of voting shall be by a General or Special Conference or conference committee of the ASSOCIATION as determined by the presiding officer or chairman thereof, but a vote by written ballot may not be taken.

b. Voting may be by proxy in accordance with the maximum number of delegates authorized the states as presented in writing to the Credentials Committee by the authorized delegate and as approved by the Credentials Committee.

Section 2. General Conference and Special Conference:

At a General Conference or Special Conference of the ASSOCIATION:

(1) The voting body consists of:

(a) Each accredited State delegate.

(b) Each member of the Executive Council.

(2) Each member of the voting body shall, when actually present, except as otherwise provided in the By-Laws, be entitled to one vote on each matter acted upon by the Conference.

(3) Upon demand of five or more states, the presiding officer shall order a vote by roll call of the States.

(4) In the event of a vote by roll call of the States, each state shall:

(a) Be entitled to one vote for:

(1) Each delegate accredited thereby whether or not present;

(2) Each member of the Executive Council whose membership is credited to the State.

(5) In the event of a vote by roll call of the States a member of the voting body may on the floor of the Conference demand that the members of the voting body be polled, in which case the Secretary of the Conference shall:

(a) Poll the said members of the voting body accredited by or credited to the state concerned.

1 (b) Determine the votes thereof.

2 (c) Record the total number of votes to which that state is
3 entitled under the unit rule in the same manner provided in
4 Section 3, Sub-Section a, Paragraph (3) of this Article.

5 Section 3. Caucuses:

6 a. State Caucus:

7 (1) A state caucus consisting of the accredited state delegates and
8 any members of the Executive Council whose membership is credited to
9 that state, shall be convened whenever:

10 (a) In an Army or Air National Guard Area Caucus of which the
11 state is a part, where there are names of more eligible members
12 proposed than there are vacancies to be filled on the Executive
13 Council from the area concerned.

14 (b) A vote by roll call of the states on the floor of a General
15 or Special Conference is ordered pursuant to the demand of five
16 or more states.

17 (2) A state caucusing pursuant to clause (a) of paragraph 1 of this
18 subsection shall cause the vote of its delegate in the appropriate
19 Area Caucus to be cast for each of the two members of the ASSOCIATION
20 who receive the highest number of votes in the State Caucus.

21 (3) A state caucusing pursuant to clause (b) paragraph 1 of this
22 subsection shall cast the vote of the state under the unit rule:

23 (a) If the question is on election to an office of the
24 ASSOCIATION, for the nominee who received the highest number
25 of votes in the caucus;

26 (b) If the question is on election to the Executive Council
27 for each of the two nominees who receive the highest number
28 of votes in the caucus: or

29 (c) If the question is on the adoption or rejection of a
30 motion, as determined by majority vote of the Caucus.

31 b. National Guard Area Caucus:

32 (1) A National Guard Area Caucus consists of one Army and one Air
33 accredited delegate to a General or Special Conference from each
34 state in the geographical area concerned, designated by the President
35 of the state, and the four (4) Area Directors from the respective
36 area.

(2) National Guard Area Caucuses shall be convened at a General or Special Conference for the purpose of selecting and referring to the Committee on Nominations the names of that number of eligible members of the ASSOCIATION from the service and geographical area they represent to be nominated by that committee to fill vacancies on the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION.

(3) In a National Guard Area Caucus:

(a) The Area Chairman shall be the presiding officer.

(b) Each member shall, when actually present, be entitled to one vote on each matter acted upon by the Caucus.

(c) A vote may be taken by written ballot if so determined by a majority of the members of the Caucus present.

(4) A National Guard Area Caucus shall serve until discharged by the General Conference of which it is a part.

ARTICLE XI

FISCAL

Section 1. Fiscal Year:

The Fiscal year of the ASSOCIATION commences on July 1 and ends on June 30th.

Section 2. Audit:

A certified public accountant employed by direction of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION shall annually audit the records and finances of the ASSOCIATION and render a report thereon to the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION which shall transmit same to the Committee on Finance at the next annual General Conference.

Section 3. Funds:

In case of the dissolution of the ASSOCIATION, all assets of EANGUS will be given to the Heritage Gallery Trust Fund in the National Guard Memorial Building in Washington, D. C.

Section 4. Expenditures:

Bills, claims and expenditures of the ASSOCIATION shall be:

(1) Certified by the President or Executive Director of the ASSOCIATION.

(2) Paid by warrant drawn on the funds of the ASSOCIATION and executed by any two of the following:

- (a) President
- (b) Vice-President
- (c) Treasurer
- (d) Secretary
- (e) Executive Director

ARTICLE XII

WAR OR NATIONAL EMERGENCY

Section 1. When Article Invoked:

a. This Article may be invoked by majority of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION in the event of:

(1) War

(2) National Emergency

(a) Proclaimed by the President of the United States.

(b) Declared by the Congress of the United States.

b. This article when invoked, shall take precedence over any conflicting provision of the By-Laws of the ASSOCIATION.

Section 2. Tenure and Filling Vacancies:

On and after the date of invocation of this Article:

(1) Subject to the provisions of Article IV, Section 4, of these By-Laws, the tenure in office of each officer of the ASSOCIATION is, if so determined by a majority vote of the Executive Council of the ASSOCIATION, extended for the duration of the war or National Emergency and for six months thereafter or until the Executive Council, by majority vote determines that this Article shall no longer remain in effect.

(2) In the event of a vacancy on the Executive Council, other than an officer of the ASSOCIATION, the Executive Council shall elect thereto, by majority vote, a member of the ASSOCIATION from the appropriate National Guard area to serve the unexpired period of tenure.

(3) In the event of a vacancy in the office of President of the ASSOCIATION and there is, at that time, no Vice-President of the ASSOCIATION to succeed thereto, the Executive Council shall elect to the office of President, by majority vote, a member of the existing Executive Council.

1 (4) In the event of a vacancy in the office of Vice-President,
2 Secretary or Treasurer of the ASSOCIATION, the Executive Council
3 shall elect to that office, by majority vote, a member of the
4 ASSOCIATION.

5 (5) A member of the Executive Council elected to be an officer of
6 the ASSOCIATION vacates his original seat on the Executive Council,
7 and

8 (6) The Executive Council may suspend the operation of any provision
9 of Articles VI and/or VIII of the By-Laws.

10 ARTICLE XIII

11 AMENDMENTS

12 Section 1. By Two-Thirds Vote:

13 These By-Laws may be amended at a General or Special Conference of the
14 ASSOCIATION by a two-thirds vote of the delegates present. An amendment
15 may be proposed by a State or a member of the ASSOCIATION and shall be
16 submitted in writing to the Secretary of the ASSOCIATION at least ninety
17 (90) days prior to the date set for the convening of the Conference at
18 which the proposed amendment is to be considered. As soon as practicable
19 after its receipt, the Secretary shall mail copies of the proposed amend-
20 ment(s) to the Chairman of the By-Laws Committee. The Chairman of the
21 By-Laws Committee shall mail copies of the proposed amendment(s) to the
22 Executive Council and the Presidents of each state not less than thirty
23 (30) days prior to the date set for the convening of each Conference.
24 After Committee consideration the By-Laws Committee Chairman shall render
25 a report to such conference, with such recommendations concerning the
26 proposed amendment as the Committee may see fit.

27 Section 2. By Unanimous Vote:

28 These By-Laws may be amended at a General or Special Conference of the
29 ASSOCIATION by a unanimous vote without prior notice provided the By-Laws
30 Committee has reviewed the proposed amendment(s) and made it's recommen-
31 dation to the ASSOCIATION.

32 Section 3. Effective Date:

33 Unless otherwise provided, an amendment of the By-Laws shall be effective
34 upon the adjournment sine die of the General or Special Conference which
35 adopted it.

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes herein:

a. "State" means and includes a State, Commonwealth, Territory, and the District of Columbia.

b. "President of State Organization" means and includes the elected President of a State Organization or the elected member chosen to represent the enlisted portion of the Organization.

c. "Area Chairman" - One of the four Area Directors (from Areas 1 thru 7) appointed to serve as the coordinator for each Area.

d. "National Guard Area" means and includes:

(3) National Guard Area III - Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Puerto Rico, South Carolina and Tennessee.

(4) National Guard Area IV - Arkansas, Louisiana, Kansas, Mississippi, Missouri, Oklahoma and Texas.

(5) National Guard Area V - Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

(6) National Guard Area VI - Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming.

(7) National Guard Area VII - Alaska, California, Hawaii, Oregon and Washington.
