The following requests were made by the Blinded Veterans Association and this is the status:  
(The requests were made at a meeting on June 25)

1. The special tour of the White House for approximately 400 of their members has been arranged. Carol McCain did this very specially because usually they can only accomodate 200 people.
2. The video tape of the President greeting them at their convention has been requested.
3. The presentation of the plaque will take place at our White House briefing and meeting with the President on July 17.
4. The request to have the Vice-President speak at their banquet has been put through.
