  WHO'S DEDICATED SO MUCH OF HIS TIME AND ENERGY TO THE FIGHT
  AGAINST DRUGS IN SWEDEN. I KNOW THAT THE SUCCESS OF "ARTISTS
  AGAINST NARCOTICS" IS DUE IN LARGE PART TO HIS PARTICIPATION.

THEY'RE PEER GROUPS AGAINST DRUGS AND THEY'RE VERY, VERY EFFECTIVE. ONE OF THE BEST WAYS TO PREVENT DRUG ABUSE IS BY YOUNG PEOPLE HELPING EACH OTHER TO SAY NO.
- -- I HOPE EVERY ONE OF YOU WILL ALWAYS SAY NO TO DRUGS AND HELP YOUR FRIENDS AND CLASSMATES DO THE SAME THING. THE REASON IT'S IMPORTANT IS BECAUSE YOU'RE SWEDEN'S FUTURE LEADERS. YOUR COUNTRY NEEDS YOU TO BE STRONG, CLEAR-THINKING INDIVIDUALS.

  DRUGS CAN TAKE AWAY YOUR STRENGTH AND YOUR COMMITMENT AND YOUR HOPE. JUST REMEMBER, WHEN YOU "BARA SAG NEJ" [BAHRA-SAY-NAY] TO DRUGS, YOU ARE SAYING YES TO EVERYTHING YOU LOVE AND EVERYTHING YOU WANT TO BE.
