REMARKS FOR THE EDGEMEADE SCHOOL VISIT THURSDAY, JANUARY 21, 1988

- -- THANK YOU, I'M VERY GLAD THAT WE COULD BE TOGETHER THIS MORNING. BECAUSE THERE'S SOMETHING VERY IMPORTANT I WANT TO TALK TO YOU ABOUT.

 YOUR DETERMINATION. IF YOU WANT GOOD GRADES, DRUGS WILL MAKE YOU
 FAIL.
- -- SINCE DRUGS TAKE AWAY WHAT WE WANT MOST, YOU'D THINK IT
 WOULD BE EASY TO SAY NO. BUT SAYING NO IS OFTEN HARDER THAN

SAYING YES, BECAUSE SOMETIMES THE PERSON OFFERING THE DRUG IS A FRIEND, A MEMBER OF THE FAMILY, MAYBE EVEN A PARENT.

-- SOMETIMES THE PERSON OFFERING THE DRUG RIDES AROUND IN A BIG CAR WITH LOTS OF MONEY. BUT WHEN YOU SEE THE DRUG DEALER IN HIS BIG CAR AND HIS NICE CLOTHES, REMEMBER THAT HE GOT THOSE THINGS BY HURTING OTHER PEOPLE. HE GOT THOSE THINGS BY DESTROYING OTHER PEOPLE'S DREAMS. AND YET IN SPITE OF ALL THAT, I KNOW IT CAN BE HARD TO RESIST HIS INFLUENCE.
