REMARKS FOR HOWE HIGH SCHOOL VISIT THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 4, 1988

-- THANK YOU, MR. WILLIAMS, FOR THIS CHECK. AND THANK YOU FOR HELPING OUR YOUNG PEOPLE STAY DRUG-FREE. I'VE GENUINELY ENJOYED MY PARTNERSHIP WITH KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL THE LAST SEVERAL YEARS. IT'S SAID THAT IF YOU WANT SOMETHING DONE, ASK A BUSY PERSON. I THINK THE SAME THING CAN BE SAID FOR ORGANIZATIONS. KIWANIS CERTAINLY HAS PROVEN THAT. YOUR LEADERSHIP IN THE FIGHT AGAINST DRUG ABUSE IS OUTSTANDING.

- -- I GUESS YOU KNOW THAT I'VE JUST COME FROM A SESSION WITH WAYMAN TISDALE AND THE TISDALE TEAM. WAYMAN, YOU'RE DOING A MARVELOUS JOB. THE PRESSURE YOU FEEL TO BE ACCEPTED, THE PRESSURE FROM PEERS TO DO THINGS YOU MAY NOT ALWAYS THINK ARE RIGHT. THERE ARE NO EASY ANSWERS TO THESE PRESSURES. BUT THE PRESSURES ARE WHAT'S GOING TO MAKE YOU ADULTS.

-- SINCE THERE AREN'T EASY WAYS OUT OF THE DIFFICULTIES ALL YOUNG PEOPLE FACE, IT'S IMPORTANT THAT YOU REACH OUT AND HELP EACH OTHER. KIWANIS IS MAKING THAT EASIER, SO IS WAYMAN TISDALE. BUT THE BEST HELP FOR YOUNG COMES FROM YOU . . . THEIR PEERS.

IT'S IMPORTANT THAT YOU BE THERE TO HELP A FRIEND WITH A PROBLEM, ESPECIALLY DRUG PROBLEMS. IT'S IMPORTANT THAT YOU BE THERE FOR SUPPORT. PERHAPS IF YOU ARE THERE FROM THE START, YOU CAN HELP THEM EVEN STAY OFF DRUGS IN THE FIRST PLACE. THAT'S A VERY TOUGH TASK. BUT REALLY, WHO ELSE IS BETTER FOR THAT JOB THAN YOU? WHO DO YOUNG PEOPLE TRUST MORE THAN THEIR FRIENDS?

-- WHEN PEOPLE TALK ABOUT PEER PRESSURE, IT DOESN'T HAVE TO MEAN SOMETHING BAD.

INTERESTING, FASCINATING, AND DRUG-FREE LIFE. I LIKE THE WHOLE

IDEA OF YOUNG PEOPLE WORKING FOR, AND TEACHING OTHER YOUNG PEOPLE

EVERYTHING GOOD ABOUT LIFE. THAT'S JUST WHAT THE TISDALE TEAM DOES.

-- I GET MANY LETTERS FROM PEOPLE WHOSE LIVES HAVE BEEN

DESTROYED BY DRUGS. ONE LETTER I RECEIVED CAME FROM A YOUNG MAN

WHO SHOT HIMSELF AND NEARLY DIED. IT WAS QUAALUDES THAT

DISORIENTED HIM, BUT IT COULD HAVE BEEN ANY DRUG.

POSITIVE PEER PRESSURE CAN STEER PEOPLE ON A ROAD TO A HEALTHY,

HE SAID: "WITH EACH NEW DRUG I TRIED, I WOULD LAUGH AT THE THOUGHT THAT THEY WERE DANGEROUS . . . UNTIL THE DAY I ENDED UP WITH A BULLET IN MY HEAD . . ."
