Muffie Brandon wrote you suggesting that the President might wish to invite UN Secretary General Perez de Cuellar to lunch in the future or, if that is not practical, asking whether you would consider having him included in the Peruvian State dinner (Tab II). The memo at Tab I would support the latter idea. You should also be aware that Perez de Cuellar may be in Washington in late May, and State will likely recommend a call on the President at that time. The response to Brandon need not go into that.


