The President has asked me to respond to your letter of July 13 concerning the rehabilitation of your office. I was saddened to hear that your office equipment was destroyed and your building was severely damaged in an NPA attack. It is unfortunate that the Communist New People's Army stages terrorist attacks that destroy property and reduce the ability of the government to help the people of the Philippines.

Unfortunately the Government of the United States does not have discretionary funds to help victims of Communist attacks such as yourselves. Our economic assistance to the Philippines is programmed in consultation with the Philippine Government. I sincerely hope that you will be able to obtain relief from your own Government.

Sir:

I am a local Government Officer III of the municipality of Claver, province of Surigao del Norte, Philippines. I am writing this letter to your honorable office with the hope that I could be given assistance in the rehabilitation of my office which was damaged and ransacked by the NPA rebels on July 11, 1988. This is the story:

At 8:30 A.M., four jeeps loaded with heavily armed NPA rebels attacked the whole municipality of Claver. Two jeeps stopped at the Philippine Army Headquarters, one jeep stopped at the new municipal building and one jeep stopped at the Police headquarters. The two headquarters were easily overran by the NPAs which resulted in the killing of 3 military men. We in the municipal hall were ordered to come downstairs and made to lie flat on the ground facing the ground. Then they started opening the steel cabinet of the Treasurer, took our new typewriters and shot the old typewriters, office tables, wallings, roofings and destroying the offices. My office where the SSB radio was placed was destroyed and . they took my new personal Ofympia typewriter and the SSB radio. The gun battle lasted until 10:00 A.M. There were about 300 heavily armed NPA rebels that attacked our municipality.

Now, our office works are affected because we have no more typewriters.

It is at this point that I dare to request from you and your Honorable office for a little finemancial assistance in the rehabilitation of my office and request even for a second-hand typewriter for my office. I cannot ask financial assistance from our local government because they are also facing a big problem in the rehabilitation of our destroyed municipal building of which cost of damages is estimated to be more or less \$300,000.00.

Thank you and may you be given good luck and good health.

# MALACAÑAN PALACE

February 24, 1988

Dear President Reagan,

Last year was worst, and the greatest threat came, sadly, from those whose highest duty it is to protect rather than harm the Republic. But we weathered that storm. We are stronger for it, I think, if only because we have no more illusions about the way to enduring democracy and substantial progress. That way was pointed out to me by a good and wise friend, George Shultz, who advised me to go it alone with my people in the work of recovery and progress. The Philippines, he said, must show it can do it alone, before she can expect any substantial help. The strong and self-reliant invite admiration, and with admiration, support.

I believe my people have proved self-reliant and strong, manfully meeting their obligations at home and abroad --particularly in the matter of the foreign debt (no other nation has hewed so closely to the conditions of restructuring and fulfilled them so completely) and regional security. I said it would be that way when I addressed the U.S. Congress during that wonderful visit to your country. I have kept my word.

It is better this way. In your words, to stand tall and proud.

Indeed, at the appropriate time, we shall reexamine in that light and posture the present dominant role of the Philippines in the stability and security of the Asia-Pacific region.

Thank you for your generous compliments and your deep concern for my country. My warm regards to Mrs. Reagan.

It was a difficult year for both of us, but, as I believe, such things can only make us stronger.
