Air Force One Worksheet

1. Students' answers may vary, but are likely to include the following: making phone calls, debriefing of issues, meeting with staff/advisors, holding conferences.
2. Air Force One can be referred to as the "Flying White House" because the President's suite on AFO serves as the Oval Office when the President is on board. AFO provides security and state of the art communication in order for the President to conduct business while traveling.
3. President Franklin Delano Roosevelt was the first president to take a presidential flight.
4. Seven presidents flew on Air Force One, tail number 27000 (Nixon, Ford, Carter, Reagan, H.W. Bush, Clinton, W. Bush).
5. President Reagan was accompanied by his senior advisors, secret service agents, and his wife, Nancy.
6. "The Football" is a briefcase that contains the special codes in order for the president to respond to a nuclear attack. It is carried by the President's Military Aide. On SAM 27000 the aide is represented by Lieutenant Colonel Chealander who traveled to Reykjavik with the President.
