Dear Glenn:

I'm glad you have given me an opportunity to correct what is obviously some misinformation you have received. I'm curious as to who might have misinformed you. Whoever it was, either was ignorant of the facts or was guilty of an outright lie. I think the figures I've enclosed will prove that I have not been lying.

Glenn, before you check out the figures let me give you some additional facts. Our missiles, the landbased ICBMs, are not more sophisticated and superior. Our latest, the Minute Man III, is over 15 years old and doesn't have the accuracy or power needed to handle the hardened silos of the Soviets. That's why we want the MX. It is equal to the Soviets' SS-18s and 19s but we're only asking for 100 of these and they won't all be operational for several more years.

By 1981, the Soviets had achieved an advantage in nearly every measure of strategic capability such as strategic missiles, warheads, bombers and throw-weight. At the same time, they continued to tilt the conventional and nuclear balance in Europe further in their favor; they increased and modernized their already considerable forces in Asia, and they increased their ability to project their forces and those of their allies throughout the third World.

We are trying to modernize at the same time we seek effective arms reductions to reduce the risks of war and to increase global stability. If you need any additional information, please let me know. 


