I would like to invite you to speak on "the proper understanding of the separation of Church and State" at a briefing for the Board of Directors of the National Jewish Coalition. The Coalition is the only nation-wide Jewish organization which has publicly committed itself to the Administration's conservative philosophy of government. Its Board of Directors is composed primarily of prestigious Jewish-Americans who have given generously of their time and resources to Administration causes. Your participation in the briefing would be an important expression of the Administration's appreciation for their past and present support.


