DATE: February 3, 1986

The White House Office of Public Liaison has submitted a request for a "walk through" appearance by the Vice President for a briefing in the Old Executive Office Building.

The group includes leading Republican Jewish activists from key cities across the nation. Among the participants are members of some of the most prominent Jewish families in America:

Tom <u>Tisch</u> (New York)
Phil <u>Fisher</u> (Detroit)
Thomas <u>Pritzker</u> (Chicago)

This select group was chosen from their leadership activities in the Reagan Bush Campaigns in 1980 and 1984. The participants will be important organizers and fundraisers in the 1986 G.O.P. Senate races. The majority are between the ages of 30 and 40. These individuals have been activists in their own communities, assuming leadership roles in the state party apparatus.

Each of the participants is linked up with an important network of political activists-concentrated in the nine states with the largest number of electoral votes.

It would be safe to predict that a substantial number will go on to become delegates to the 1988 Republican National Convention. Furthermore, some will play significant roles in fundraising activities in the 1988 primary cycle.
