Government-issued tickets shall be used for official trips only (i.e., no political or personal travel). The entire cost of any government-issued tickets that are used for unofficial travel will be considered a personal travel advance and treated accordingly.

- 4. TO OBTAIN REIMBURSEMENT, RECEIPTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL EXPENDITURES REGARDLESS OF THE AMOUNT
