SUBJECT: Foreign Assistance Initiative

The attached memorandum to Shultz and Weinberger at Tab I is the first step in our campaign to reinvigorate the foreign assistance program and recover from the inadequate funding of the latest foreign assistance authorization. It highlights the President's commitment to emphasize this area during the remainder of this Administration and maps out a series of steps to effect this change.

Our most immediate task is to decide precisely how to approach a supplemental request this Fall. Details will be worked out between State, Defense, NSC and OMB over the next two weeks. Beyond that -- as we have already discussed -- we need to come up with a more imaginative rationale and program for the long haul.
