Dear Bill:

On July 13, I was presented with the letter that you and 145 of your House colleagues signed pledging veto support on excessive spending bills. Because of the overriding importance of Federal spending policies on the Nation's economic recovery, I want to extend my personal thanks for your expression of support -- and my assurance that I will not hesitate to use the veto if bloated spending bills reach my desk.

Our policies are working. Even our strongest critics can no longer deny that the Nation's economy is recovering. We're seeing strong economic growth while inflation is at its lowest level in a decade. Unemployment is still too high, but it's coming down, and the prospect is for continued improvement as the economic recovery proceeds.

We must not abort the recovery by returning to the failed tax and tax, spend and spend policies embodied in the Budget Resolution which was adopted by the Congress on June 23. As you know, as President, I cannot sign or veto the Budget Resolution itself once it clears Congress. But I do have the right -- and the responsibility -- to act on authorization and appropriation bills which reach my desk. You can be sure that I will use the veto again and again, if necessary, to head off undisciplined spending and tax increases.

I'm convinced that the letter presented to me in May, which showed that we could sustain vetoes of unwise tax legislation in the House, was helpful in heading off the attempt to cap the third year of the tax cut. I fully expect that the letter you signed on excessive spending measures will be of similar benefit in protecting the recovery and keeping the lid on runaway spending.

Again, please accept my gratitude for your partnership in the cause of lasting economic recovery.

On July 13, I was presented with the letter that you and 145 of your House colleagues signed pledging veto support on excessive spending bills. Because of the overriding importance of Federal spending policies on the Nation's economic recovery, I want to extend my personal thanks for your expression of support -- and my assurance that I will not hesitate to use the veto if bloated spending bills reach my desk.

Our policies are working. Even our strongest critics can no longer deny that the Nation's economy is recovering. We're seeing strong economic growth while inflation is at its lowest level in a decade. Unemployment is still too high, but it's coming down, and the prospect is for continued improvement as the economic recovery proceeds.

Caracter for for

We must not abort the recovery by returning to the failed tax and tax spend and spend policies embodied in the Budget Resolution which was adopted by the Congress on June 23. As you know, as President, I cannot sign or veto the Budget Resolution itself once it clears Congress. But I do have the right — and the responsibility — to act on authorization and appropriation bills which reach my desk. You can be sure that I will use the veto again and again, if necessary, to head off undisciplined spending and tax increases.

I'm convinced that the letter presented to me in May, which showed that we could sustain vetoes of unwise tax legislation in the House was helpful in heading off the attempt to cap the third year of the tax cut. I fully expect that the letter you signed on excessive spending measures will be of similar benefit in protecting the recovery and keeping the lid on runaway spending.
