- 1. (C) ENTIRE TEXT.
- 2. THE MEDIA HERE HAVE GIVEN PROMINENT ATTENTION TO FY-83 ASSISTANCE LEVELS PROPOSED BY THE ADMINISTRATION -98 MILLION DOLLARS. PORTUGUESE OFFICIALS WILL LOSE CONFIDENCE IN OUR ABILITY AND WILL TO DELIVER IF A CONTINUING RESOLUTION REDUCES THEIR ASSISTANCE TO ONLY \$18 MILLION GRANT AND ONLY \$45 MILLION IN GUARANTEED CREDITS. ALL THE MORE IF THAT SAME CONTINUING RESOLUTION CARRIES EXCEPTIONAL ASSISTANCE FOR ISRAEL, LEBANON, TURKEY AND OTHERS.
- 3. FORMAL NEGOTIATIONS ON LAJES AND OTHER U.S. SECURITY NEEDS SHOULD BEGIN THIS MONTH. THE AGREEMENT EXPIRES IN FEBRUARY 1983. IN REFTEL A, WE OUTLINED A REVISED APPROACH TO THE NEGOTIATIONS THAT WE BELIEVE COULD LEAD TO A FAIRLY RAPID AGREEMENT. THAT STRATEGY HINGES, HOWEVER, ON OUR ABILITY TO CONVINCE THE PORTUGUESE THAT OUR "BEST EFFORTS" PLEDGE WILL BRING THEM SECURITY ASSISTANCE IN SUFFICIENT AMOUNTS TO HELP THEM TO FINANCE THEIR MILITARY MODERNIZATION PROGRAM. SINCE THE COMPETENT GERMAN PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEES WILL HAVE TO DEBATE THE GRANTING AND THE USE OF THE NEXT TRANCHE OF GERMAN NATO ASSISTANCE FOR PORTUGAL. - 1. (C) FOREIGN MINISTRY DEPUTY POLITICAL DIRECTOR FARIA YESTERDAY (NOVEMBER 16) TOLD THE DCM THAT THE UNITED STATES IS NOW IN ITS LAST PERIOD OF LAJES USAGE ON A BASI OF "GOOD WILL". FARIA HAD JUST SIGNED THE "JADE TIGER" EXERCISE PERMISSION (AFTER AN HOUR'S DISCUSSION), AND NOTED HE WAS DOING SO BEFORE OBTAINING THE REQUIRED CONSENT OF THE AZOREAN REGIONAL GOVERNMENT. HE ALSO NOTED THAT THE MINISTRY ON THIS OCCASION HAD CARRIED THE DAY AGAINST NAY-SAYERS IN THE PORTUGUESE DEFENSE ESTAB-LISHMENT WHO HAD BEEN ARGUING THAT PORTUGAL SHOULD BE IN NO RUSH TO APPROVE "JADE TIGER" ON SUCH SHORT (TWO WEEKS') NOTICE, UNLESS OR UNTIL THE U.S. SHOWS CONCRETELY IT CAN BE MORE RESPONSIVE TO PORTUGAL'S TOP-MOST DEFENSE PRIORITY NEEDS.
- 2. (C) IN THIS REGARD, FARIA SAID IT WILL BE ESSENTIAL TO GET A NEW BASE AGREEMENT QUICKLY AND TO SHOW SUBSTANT-IAL IMPROVEMENT OVER OUR FY 82 MILITARY ASSISTANCE. IF WE FALL SHORT ON EITHER GOAL THERE WILL BE IRRESISTIBLE PRESSURE FROM THE DEFENSE ESTABLISHMENT TO SQUEEZE OUR PRESENT OPEN-ENDED TRANSIT RIGHTS TO NON-NATO DESTI-NATIONS IN A LAST EFFORT TO GET THE NECESSARY MILITARY ASSISTANCE. FARIA SPECIFICALLY ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THE U.S. EXECUTIVE BRANCH HAD TRIED TO IMPROVE FY 83 ASSISTANCE LEVELS SUBSTANTIALLY. BUT, HE SAID, THE PORTUGUESE CLEARLY UNDERSTAND THAT THE CONGRESS FINALLY DECIDES THE LEVELS. IF THE LEVELS ARE NOT IMPROVED DESPITE THE OBVIOUS EFFORTS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, THAT WILL SIMPLY PROVE TO THE PORTUGUESE THAT THEY HAVE TO FIND DRAMATIC WAYS TO GET CONGRESSIONAL ATTENTION.
- 3. (C) AS I NOTED IN MY PROPOSALS ON A NEGOTIATING STRATEGY (REF C) WITH WHICH YOU HAVE AGREED (REF A), WE MUST SHOW A CLEARLY RISING LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE IN FY 82-8 TO HAVE ANY CHANCE OF SUCCESS. IT WILL BE DISASTROUS IF

I HAVE TO GO INTO THIS NEGOTIATION WITH EITHER NO NUMBERS TO TABLE FOR FY 83 OR AN INITIAL FY 83 ASSISTANCE LEVEL THE SAME AS THE BASIC FY 82 LEVEL (THAT IS, \$10 MILLION GRANT AND \$45 MILLION GUARANTEED CREDITS).

4. (C) I URGE IN STRONGEST TERMS YOUR PERSONAL ATTENTION TO THE QUESTION OF FY 83 APPROPRIATIONS AND THE RISK THAT WE MAY HAVE TO OPERATE SEVERAL MORE MONTHS ON CONTINUING RESOLUTIONS. IF WE ARE TO HAVE A CONTINUING RESOLUTION. IT IS ABSOLUTELY ESSENTIAL THAT THERE BE A LINE ITEM FOR PORTUGAL THAT BOOSTS US TO THE \$90 MILLION CASH FLOW LEVEL ORIGINALLY PROPOSED FOR PORTUGAL. OTHERWISE, AFTE TWO BAD YEARS IN A ROW, THE ADMINISTRATION'S REQUEST FOR FY 84 SIMPLY WILL NOT HAVE THE NECESSARY CREDIBILITY WITH THE PORTUGUESE. HOLMES
