Discussion

S. 2948, which passed both Houses by voice vote, authorizes the President to promote the late Air Force Lt. Col. Ellison S. Onizuka to the rank of Colonel. He was one of two military men on the Challenger spacecraft that exploded on January 28, 1986.

S. 2948 specifies that no increase in compensation or benefits based on Lt. Col. Onizuka's military service is to result from the posthumous promotion.


Under Presidential astronaut promotion policy, only one promotion is allowed through the grade of Colonel for an astronaut's first space mission. Further promotions are granted only if the astronaut lands on extraterrestrial bodies in subsequent missions. Lt. Col. Onizuka had been promoted to his current grade for a previous space mission flown in February 1985, and would not have been entitled to another promotion if he had survived the Challenger disaster.

In its report to the Senate Armed Services Committee on a predecessor bill to S. 2948, the Air Force supported Lt. Col. Onizuka's posthumous promotion because of the unique circumstances of his death.

Navy Commander Michael J. Smith, the other military member on the fatal Challenger mission, has already receive a posthumous promotion to Captain, a rank to which he would have been entitled had he survived. Unlike the prohibition on increased benefits in S. 2948, a provision in the 1987 full-year Continuing Resolution (P.L. 99-500) has granted Captain Smith's family an increase in Dependency and Indemnity Compensation benefits based on his posthumous promotion.

Recommendations

The Department of Defense (Air Force) recommends approval of the bill, and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration has no objection to enactment. I concur, and recommend that you approve S. 2948.



Dear Mr. Director:

Reference is made to your request of October 23, 1986, for the views of the Department of Defense with respect to S. 2948, 99th Congress, an enrolled bill, "To authorize the President to promote posthumously the late Lieutenant Colonel Ellison S. Onizuka to the grade of Colonel." The Secretary of Defense has delegated to the Department of the Air Force the responsibility for expressing the views of the Department of Defense on this enrolled enactment.

The purpose of the enrolled bill is to posthumously promote Lieutenant Colonel Ellison S. Onizuka to the grade of Colonel. However, no increase in compensation or benefits will be allowed based on the posthumous promotion.


The Department of the Air Force on behalf of the Department of Defense supports S. 2948. Even though Lieutenant Colonel Onizuka received an astronaut promotion as a result of a space flight in February 85, the Air Force supports his promotion to Colonel because of the precedent set by the posthumous promotion of fellow crewmember Commander Michael Smith, to Captain.

Enactment of S. 2948 will not result in increased budgetary requirements for the Department of Defense.

For these reasons, the Department of the Air Force, on behalf of the Department of Defense, recommends approval of this enrolled bill by the President.



The President today signed the following legislation:

H.R. 2574, which grants retroactive coverage to Christopher Eney under the Public Safety Officers' Benefits Act, thus making his survivors eligible for benefits under the Act.

H.R. 5682, which authorizes the Secretary of the Navy either to sell the former Naval Training Center in Bainbridge, Cecil County, Maryland, to private parties for fair market value or to transfer it to other government agencies.

S. 2948, which authorizes the President to promote Lt. Col. Ellison S. Onizuka posthumously.
