Subject: Recommendation for an Appointment with President Reagan for Pakistan Foreign Minister Yaqub Khan

The Department recommends that Pakistan Foreign Minister Yaqub be given an appointment with President Reagan in order that he may deliver an important letter from Pakistan President Zia-ul-Haq.

BACKGROUND

Pakistan Foreign Minister Yaqub Khan will be in Washington May 18 to 22, for consultations on US-Pakistan relations and Afghanistan. He will be meeting the Secretary on the 18th and has requested that he have an opportunity, briefly, to meet with the President to deliver an important letter to the President from Pakistan President Zia-ul-Haq. We recommend that time be made available on the President's schedule for this purpose during the week of May 18.
