Crown Prince Fahd's Principles for Peace

1. That Israel should withdraw from all Arab territory occupied in 1967, including Arab Jerusalem.
2. That Israeli settlements built on Arab land after 1967 should be dismantled.
3. A guarantee of freedom of worship for all religions in the Holy Places.
4. An affirmation of the right of the Palestinian people to return to their homes and to compensate those who do not wish to return.
5. That the West Bank and the Gaza Strip should have a transitional period under the auspices of the U.N. for a period not exceeding several months.
6. That an independent Palestinian State should be set up with Jerusalem as its capital.
7. That all states in the region should be able to live in peace.
8. That the U.N. or member states of the U.N. should guarantee the execution of these principles.

SUBJECT: Proposed Meeting of President with  
the Foreign Ministers of Saudi Arabia  
and Syria

In a July 5 message to King Fahd (Tab B), the President indicated that he looked forward to talks with Saudi Foreign Minister Saud and Syrian Foreign Minister Khaddam later in the month.

Saud and Khaddam would come as representatives of the Arab League, which is sending delegations to the capitals of other permanent members of the United Nations Security Council.

Their main goal is to seek U.S. views on Lebanon and report back to the League's Council. However, Saud wishes to use the meeting to address longer-range problems in the region, including the peace process.

Both State and I concur with their request to see the President sometime during the week of July 12.

A schedule outline is attached at Tab A for you to forward to Frederick Ryan.

I'm sorry to have blindsided you this morning.  
I had sent the request to the West Coast last  
week but it obviously did not get to you.

The Saudis have been trying to prevent the radical  
Arab states from calling for sanctions against the  
US for our perceived "tilt" toward Israel.  
To do that, Fahd convened the moderates in Taif  
last week. The upshot was: 1. to preempt the  
Tunisian meeting of the Arab league, but also, 2  
To need something to vent the considerable  
criticism building up among eventhe moderates.

The vehicle chosen was a round of meeting  
by deputized foreign ministers to Europe,  
the Soviet Union and the US. The two guys  
chosen to come to the US were the Saudi and  
Syrian foreign ministers--Saud and Khaddam.

They propose to come either the 13th, 14th or  
15th. It would require 30min to an hour.
