DEAR MARGARET,

IN RESPONSE TO YOUR MESSAGE OF OCTOBER 24, WE HAVE IDENTIFIED FOUR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE EXPERTS IN THE AREA OF LONG DELAY TIMING DEVICES FOR TERRORIST EXPLOSIVES. I HAVE DIRECTED THAT THESE PERSONNEL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO CONFER WITH YOUR EXPERTS IN THIS AREA.

AS YOU REQUESTED, OUR STATE DEPARTMENT WILL WORK THROUGH YOUR AMBASSADOR IN WASHINGTON TO ARRANGE FOR OUR RESPECTIVE EXPERTS TO MEET IN REGARDS TO THIS PROBLEM. I SHARE YOUR BELIEF THAT BY WORKING TOGETHER WE CAN MORE QUICKLY DENY THIS BRUTAL TACTIC TO THOSE WHO WOULD USE TERRORISM TO ATTACK THE FOUNDATIONS OF DEMOCRACY.
