The French in the first year and a half of Mitterrand weakened the internal security organizations (SDECE and DST), and boasted of their great toleration of political refugees. While the French exulted in their civilized behavior, the "political refugees" went about their business of establishing a cell structure, safe houses, arms depots, transportation nets, and the like, so that when the time came to move against a Right-wing government, all the elements were in place.

That is what happens when a nation refuses to believe that "it can happen here," and when it treats its own police and intelligence services as the greatest threat to its internal security.

Mr. Meese should be reminded of this, as should Mrs. President.

Attached at Tab I is a memo from you to the President requesting that he authorize release of the cable at Tab A forwarding letters to President Mitterrand and Prime Minister Chirac commending the French government for their recent steps to stem the wave of current terrorist acts.

Your memo is self-explanatory and makes reference to the Paris cable at Tab II. Please note that in all of our discussions on Georges Ibrahim Abdallah, Ambassador Rodgers has been fully supportive of our efforts to ensure that Abdallah is detained by French authorities. He does not believe that the USG has "brought on" this wave of terrorism in France -- but has accurately reported the sentiment of some in France who would have released Abdallah as a means of avoiding LARF reprisals.

The OSG principals concur. Ty Cobb concurs.

Issue

Letters to President Mitterrand and Prime Minister Chirac.

Background

The recent campaign of terror in France appears to be the result of the French government's refusal to release Georges Ibrahim Abdallah, a convicted Lebanese Armed Revolutionary Faction (LARF) terrorist. This weekend, Prime Minister Chirac announced tough new immigration and visa requirements for entry into France. These measures are now the most stringent in Europe and should help to reduce French vulnerability in the long-term.

Discussion

The measures undertaken by the French government will undoubtedly result in considerable domestic criticism. Chirac had proposed taking these steps several months ago, but was thwarted by Socialist opponents politically allied with President Mitterrand. Your letters included in the cable at Tab A commend the French for the courage to take these steps and offer any assistance that the French may want in contending with the current resurgence of terrorism.

State, Defense, and CIA concur in the letters.



1. SUMMARY: THE COE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY SEPTEMBER 18TH DEBATED AND APPROVED A STRONGLY WORDED RESOLUTION DIRECTED AT THE UPCOMING COUNCIL OF EUROPE MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE ON COMBATTING TERRORISM. THE CONFERENCE WILL BE HELD IN CLOSED SESSION IN STRASBOURG NOVEMBER 4 AND 5, 1986. IT WILL BE LIMITED TO COE MEMBER STATES. THE RESOLUTION WHICH EXPRESSES THE UNANIMOUS SENSE OF THE ASSEMBLY CALLS ON THE MINISTERS TO ADOPT STRONG MEASURES TO COMBAT TERRORISM, INCLUDING THE IMPOSITION OF DIPLOMATIC, ECONOMIC AND POLITICAL SANCTIONS. IT BRANDS TERRORISM AS A CRIME AGAINST HUMANITY. IT NAMES LIBYA, SYRIA AND IRAN AS STATES DIRECTLY SUPPORTING INTERNATIONAL TERRORIST ACTIVITIES. THE RESOLUTION AND ACCOMPANYING REPORT PROPOSE THE ESTABLISHMENT BY A PARTIAL AGREEMENT OF A NEW FLEXIBLE GROUP OF EUROPEAN MINISTERS TO COMBAT TERRORISM. MOST SPEAKERS IN THE DEBATE FOCUSED ATTENTION ON THE NEED FOR BROAD COOPERATION ON TERRORISM, INCLUDING COOPERATION WITH THE UNITED STATES AND LIKEMINDED COUNTRIES. THE PARLIAMENTARIANS ALSO PUSHED FOR DIRECT PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS. END SUMMARY.

2. THE RESOLUTION AND REPORT WERE PREPARED IN ISTANBUL LAST JULY BY THE COE POLITICAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE. BUT THE RECENT SPATE OF TERRORIST ACTS IN FRANCE AND ELSEWHERE PROVIDED A NEW URGENCY TO THE DEBATE. THE PARLIAMENTARIANS WANTED TO USE THE OCASSION TO EXPRESS POPULAR SENTIMENT CONCERNING TERRORISM AND THE NEED FOR JOINT EUROPEAN ACTION. SEVERAL SPEAKERS VOICED INCREASING FRUSTRATION AT THE FAILURE OF EUROPEAN GOVERNMENTS TO PUBLICLY DEMONSTRATE EUROPEAN UNITY IN THE FIGHT AGAINST TERRORISM. WE ARE ADDRESSING THE UPCOMING MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE AND ITS PARTICIPANTS DIRECTLY, SAID REPORT AUTHOR GIUSEPPE AMADEI (ITALY - SOCIAL DEMOCRAT), IT WOULD BE SUPERFLUOUS TO APPEAL AGAIN TO THE COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS. IT WAS THE HOPE OF THE POLITICAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, HE SAID, THAT NON - EUROPEAN DEMOCRACIES, IN PARTICULAR THE UNITED STATES, JAPAN AND CANADA,

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U N C L A S S I F I E D

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BE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF THE GROUP.

3. ITALIAN FOREIGN MINISTER ANDREOTTI, CHAIRMAN OF THE COE COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS, EXPRESSED SYMPATHY FOR THE IDEA OF INCREASED COOPERATION AMONG THE INDUSTRIALIZED DEMOCRACIES. AN EFFECTIVE RESPONSE TO TERRORISM, HE SAID, MUST BE BASED ON COOPERATION AMONG THE DEMOCRATIC STATES FOR WHICH THIS TYPE OF STRUGGLE IS ALL THE MORE UNACCEPTABLE. FOR THIS REASON THE COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS HAD DECIDED TO GIVE CONCRETE EXPRESSION TO SUCH A POLICY BY AGREEING TO CONVENE A CONFERENCE OF THE

COMPETENT EUROPEAN MINISTERS ON 4 AND 5 NOVEMBER AND ALSO EXTENDING CO-OPERATION TO THOSE NON-MEMBER STATES WHICH SHARE THE SAME CONCERNS. HE EXPRESSED CONFIDENCE THAT THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE WOULD PAY DUE ATTENTION TO THE VIEWS ON TERRORISM EXPRESSED BY THE ASSEMBLY. (COMMENT: CONGEN WAS TOLD BY COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS REPRESENTATIVES THAT THE COMMITTEE OF MINISTERS HAD IN FACT DECIDED TO STRICTLY LIMIT THE CONFERENCE TO ONLY MINISTERS FROM THE 21 COE MEMBER STATES. ANDRIOTTIS REMARKS, THEY SAID, MEANT ONLY THAT THE CONFERENCE WOULD ADDRESS HOW TO EXPAND ANTI-TERRORISM COOPERATION TO LIKE-MINDED STATES. -- SEE SEPTTEL).

4. SEVERAL PARLIAMENTARIANS EXPRESSED ANGER THAT THE CONFERENCE WAS TO BE CLOSED TO BOTH LIKEMINDED STATES AND PARLIAMENTARIANS. ON MOTION THE BUREAU OF THE ASSEMBLY WAS AUTHORIZED TO SEEK TO ENSURE THAT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ASSEMBLY WERE PRESENT AT THE CONFERENCE. WE, FROM THE ASSEMBLY SIDE, WILL IMPRESS ON THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENTS THAT THEY MUST LISTEN TO US, LEGAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN BJORN ELMQUIST (DENMARK - LIBERAL) SAID. WE ARE NOT EXPERTS ON FIGHTING TERRORISM, BUT WE ARE BETWEEN THE EXECUTIVE AUTHORITIES AND OUR POPULATIONS. THEREFORE, OUR HEAVY TASK, ON BEHALF OF OUR POPULATIONS, IS TO SECURE A DEMOCRATIC FIGHT AGAINST TERRORISM.

5) WELCOMING, AS A FIRST STEP IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION, THE MEASURES SET OUT IN THE DECLARATIONS ON INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM ADOPTED IN TOKYO ON 5 MAY 1986 BY THE HEADS OF STATE OR GOVERNMENT

OF SEVEN MAJOR DEMOCRACIES AND BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITY,

SUBJECT: UNGA GENERAL DEBATE, SEPTEMBER 24 - FRANCE

1. SUMMARY: FRENCH PRIME MINISTER JACQUES CHIRAC GAVE A DETAILED, HARD-HITTING UNGA SPEECH ON SEPTEMBER 24. HE PULLED NO PUNCHES IN SPECIFICALLY CALLING FOR SOVIET WITHDRAWAL FROM AFGHANISTAN, VIETNAMESE WITHDRAWAL FROM CAMBODIA, AND A HALT BOTH TO TERRORISM AND THE KILLING OF UN PEACEKEEPING TROOPS IN LEBANON. OVERLAPPING OF PROBLEMS IS GROWING, HE SAID, GIVING REGIONAL ISSUES A SIGNIFICANCE FAR BEYOND THEIR GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES. CHIRAC ALSO SINGLED OUT THIRD WORLD FINANCES, PALESTINE, LEBANON, IRAN-IRAQ, CYPRUS, KOREA, CENTRAL AMERICA, CHAD, THE WESTERN SAHARA, SOUTH AFRICA AND UN FINANCIAL REFORM AS SIGNIFICANT CONCERNS. HE WAS APPLAUDED FOR HIS STATEMENT THAT CAMBODIA AND AFGHANISTAN ARE NO THREATS TO THEIR POWERFUL NEIGHBORS AND SHOULD BE LIBERATED FROM THE OCCUPATIONS OF THE SOVIET UNION AND VIET NAM AND THAT LIBYA'S ATTEMPTS TO DESTABILIZE CHAD WERE REPREHENSIBLE (A STATEMENT WHICH TRIGGERED A RIGHT OF REPLY BY THE LIBYANS). END SUMMARY.

2. MULTILATERALISM: CHIRAC EXPRESSED GRATITUDE FOR THE UN AS INSTRUMENT CAPABLE OF DEALING WITH GLOBAL AND REGIONAL PROBLEMS. THE UN'S PRESENT BUDGETARY PROBLEMS WILL "DOUBTLESS" LEAD TO COMMITMENT TO REAL REFORM, WHICH IS LONG OVERDUE. NOW THAT ALLIANCES, BORDERS, AND DISTANCES ARE TRANSCENDED AT TIMES BY VIOLENT SMALL INTEREST GROUPS, MULTI-LATERAL ACTION IS ESSENTIAL. THESE PROBLEMS ARE TOO SERIOUS FOR THE UN TO BE ALLOWED TO SEEM POWERLESS. ASIDE FROM AFGHANISTAN, CAMBODIA AND CENTRAL AMERICA, HE CITED CYPRUS ("WHERE A DE FACTO SITUATION HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED WHICH FRANCE DOES NOT RECOGNIZE") AND KOREA ("A DIALOGUE... IS THE ONLY WAY TOWARD EASING TENSIONS AND THEN RESOLVING THE KOREAN QUESTION; WE WISH... FOR ALL THE KOREAN PEOPLE TO BE REPRESENTED HERE...") AND THE WESTERN SAHARA (FRANCE SUPPORTS THE MEDIATION EFFORTS OF THE SYG AND FORMER OAU PRESIDENT

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DIOUF) AS OTHER EXAMPLES OF CRISES "WHICH HAVE THWARTED THE PEACE EFFORTS" OF THE UN.

3. REGIONAL CONFLICTS:

--FRANCE RECOMMENDS SELF-DETERMINATION FOR PALESTINE.

--IN AN IMPASSIONED PLEA FOR RECONCILIATION IN LEBANON ("A PEOPLE LINKED TO FRANCE BY CENTURIES-OLD TIES OF EVERY KIND...ONCE AN EXEMPLARY MODEL OF COEXISTENCE,

TOLERANCE, LIBERTY AND CULTURE FOR THE ENTIRE WORLD") CHIRAC SPOKE OF THE SACRIFICE OF FRENCH LIVES IN PEACEKEEPING EFFORTS "IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE ISRAELI INVASION". HE NOTED THE SERIOUS CHALLENGE TO UNIFIL: REMARKING THAT THINGS HAVE WORSENERD DURING THE LAST TWO WEEKS, HE SAID THAT FRANCE MAY HAVE TO RETRENCH IN THAT MATTER FOR ITS OWN SAFETY AND THAT ALL SHOULD PROVIDE "SOLDIERS COMMENSURATE WITH THE TASK FOR LEBANON IS A CHALLENGE THAT MUST BE MET."

--NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT BASED ON SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS FOR IRAN-IRAQ.

4. HUMAN RIGHTS:

--CAMBODIA AND AFGHANISTAN, HE SAID, DEMONSTRATE A NEW FORM OF COLONIALIZATION, WORLD COLONIZATION FROM ANOTHER ERA THAT IS NO LONGER ACCEPTABLE: "FRANCE WILL CONTINUE TO SAY, ALONG WITH THE VAST MAJORITY OF STATES, THAT THE USSR AND VIETNAM, IN THEIR OWN INTEREST AND FOR THE SAKE OF THE PEACE OF THE WORLD, MUST END THEIR RESPECTIVE

5. TERRORISM: CHIRAC CALLED TERRORISM THE SYSTEMATIC WEAPON OF FACELESS ENEMIES, AND ONE OF THE TWO MOST IMPORTANT ISSUES CONFRONTING THE WORLD TODAY. THE INCREASED INCIDENCE OF TERRORISM AND THE HOLDING OF



FRENCH, BRITISH AND AMERICAN HOSTAGES IN LEBANON ARE ODIIOUS PRACTICES TO WHICH THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY HAS NOT FACED UP AS VIGOROUSLY AS IT SHOULD HAVE. COMPLICITY IN OR ENCOURAGEMENT OF TERRORISM BY GOVERNMENTS MUST BE CONDEMNED, AND CONCRETE MEASURES AGAINST HOSTAGE TAKING MUST BE TAKEN. HE CITED LIBYA FOR COMPOUNDING DIFFICULTIES IN CHAD BY ATTEMPTS TO DESTABILIZE THE COUNTRY.

6. NUCLEAR WEAPONS/NUCLEAR ENERGY: CHIRAC CREDITED NUCLEAR DETERRENCE WITH PRESERVING PEACE BETWEEN THE SUPERPOWERS, SAYING THAT THE ESSENTIAL INGREDIENT IS BALANCE BETWEEN THE TWO. FRANCE WOULD WELCOME A NEW SUPERPOWER SUMMIT. BUT FRANCE WILL NOT AGREE TO LIMITATIONS ON ITS OWN NUCLEAR FORCES RESULTING FROM

NEGOTIATIONS TO WHICH THE GOF IS NOT A PARTY. FURTHERMORE, HE STATED, FRANCE WILL NOT TOLERATE PLANNED OBSOLESCENCE OF ITS ARSENAL WHILE OTHERS MAINTAIN GIGANTIC SURPLUSES. HE CALLED FOR MORE TRANSPARENCY IN MILITARY ACTIVITIES TO INCREASE TRUST. ALTHOUGH FRANCE IS COMMITTED TO ITS PLAN OF SUBSTANTIAL RELIANCE ON NUCLEAR ENERGY, IT WILL CONTINUE TO PURSUE INCREASED NUCLEAR SAFETY. CALLING THE CHERNOBYL ACCIDENT SERIOUS, HE URGED THAT IT NOT BE A PRETEXT TO INSTIL FEAR AND IRRATIONALITY; THE FLAWS WHICH CAUSED THE DISASTER ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE TO WESTERN INSTALLATIONS. HE SAID, "THE POWER TO REGULATE BELONGS TO THOSE WHO HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY, I.E. NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS." FRANCE SUPPORTS ONLY PEACEFUL USES OF SPACE.

7. THIRD WORLD FINANCES AND DEVELOPMENT ISSUES: THESE ISSUES, ALONG WITH TERRORISM, ARE THE TWO MOST IMPORTANT GLOBAL PROBLEMS, CHIRAC DECLARED. CONDITIONS IN THE LEAST DEVELOPED COUNTRIES ARE WORSENING. FRANCE IS SUPPORTIVE OF THESE COUNTRIES. DIFFICULTIES IN MEETING DEBT PAYMENTS WILL INTERFERE WITH LONG TERM DEVELOPMENT PROBLEMS. IMAGINATIVE, ACTIVE AND PRAGMATIC FINANCIAL ADAPTATION IS NEEDED. FRANCE APPLAUDS THE RECENT PUNTE DEL ESTE CONFERENCE, AND THINKS THAT THAT DEVELOPMENT REQUIRES COOPERATION ABOVE POLITICAL AND OTHER DIFFERENCES.

8. RIGHTS OF REPLY: CHIRAC'S STATEMENTS ON LIBYA AND CAMBODIA PROVOKED RIGHTS OF REPLY, REITERATING WELL-KNOWN POSITIONS, BY LIBYA (TWICE), CHAD (TWICE), VIETNAM, CHINA, AND DEMOCRATIC KAMPUCHEA.

9. BEIRUT MINIMIZE CONSIDERED.

3. PRESENTLY, POLICE HAVE NO LEADS TO THE MURDERER, BUT DO NOT BELIEVE IT TO BE A TERRORIST INCIDENT. POLICE HAVE INDICATED THAT SUBJECT MAY HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN "OFF COLOR" DEALINGS. INFORMATION OBTAINED BY RSO INDICATED THAT SUBJECT FREQUENTED A CLUB IN PARIS CALLED "ATMOSPHERES" WHICH HAS A REPUTATION AS A HANGOUT FOR FRENCH "UNDERWORLD" FIGURES.

6. DCM HAS STATED THAT THE MISSION WILL COOPERATE WITH THE POLICE IN THIS INVESTIGATION. POLICE WILL BE AT THIS MISSION ON SEPTEMBER 26 TO BEGIN INTERVIEWING STAFF MEMBERS WHO KNEW THE SUBJECT.

7. INFORMATION DEVELOPED ON SUBJECT INDICATES THAT ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS HE PASSED HIMSELF OFF AS BEING FROM THE WHITE HOUSE. HE IS WELL KNOWN BY THE REAGAN ADMINISTRATION AND ACTIVE IN PROJECTS FOR THE WHITE HOUSE. SUBJECT CAUSED IRRITATION AMONG EMBASSY STAFF MEMBERS BY HIS OVERBEARING ATTITUDE. ON ONE OCCASION HE APPEARED AT A PARIS AIRPORT WITH BLUE POLICE LIGHTS ON HIS CAR TO MEET A WHITE HOUSE ADVANCE TEAM. HE ALSO HAD SECURITY AGENTS WITH HIM WHO WORE ID PINS SIMILAR TO THOSE WORN BY FRENCH POLICE OFFICIALS.

8. SOUHAM WAS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SOUHAM GROUP OF COMPANIES, 300 3TH AVE, NEW YORK, NY. THE COMPANY ALSO MAINTAINS OFFICES AT 39 AVE MARCEAU, PARIS, AND 421/C RUE DU MAUPAS, LAUSANNE, SWITZERLAND.
