Dear Mr. Telfer:

Reference your letter of 5 August 1985, concerning the visit of Mr. T. H. Mooney. I have discussed this matter with the Executive Director, Admiral J. L. Holloway, III, USN (Ret.) and I am pleased to extend an invitation in the Admiral's name for Mr. Mooney to visit the Vice President's Task Force on Combatting Terrorism on Tuesday, 24 September, the date you suggested would be convenient.

I think that we could usefully spend at least two hours explaining the role of the Task Force and the goals the Executive Director has set, and for an exchange of views between the officers of the Working Group and the Australian side. If it is convenient, I suggest that we commence at about 0930, and plan to have lunch when we have completed our discussions.

Would you please let me know who will accompany Mr. Mooney (and yourself?). I look forward to seeing Mr. Mooney again, and to introducing him to the Executive Director and the Working Group. For your information the Task Force has offices at 730 Jackson Place, on Lafayette Park across from the White House. Our phone number is 395-4950.
