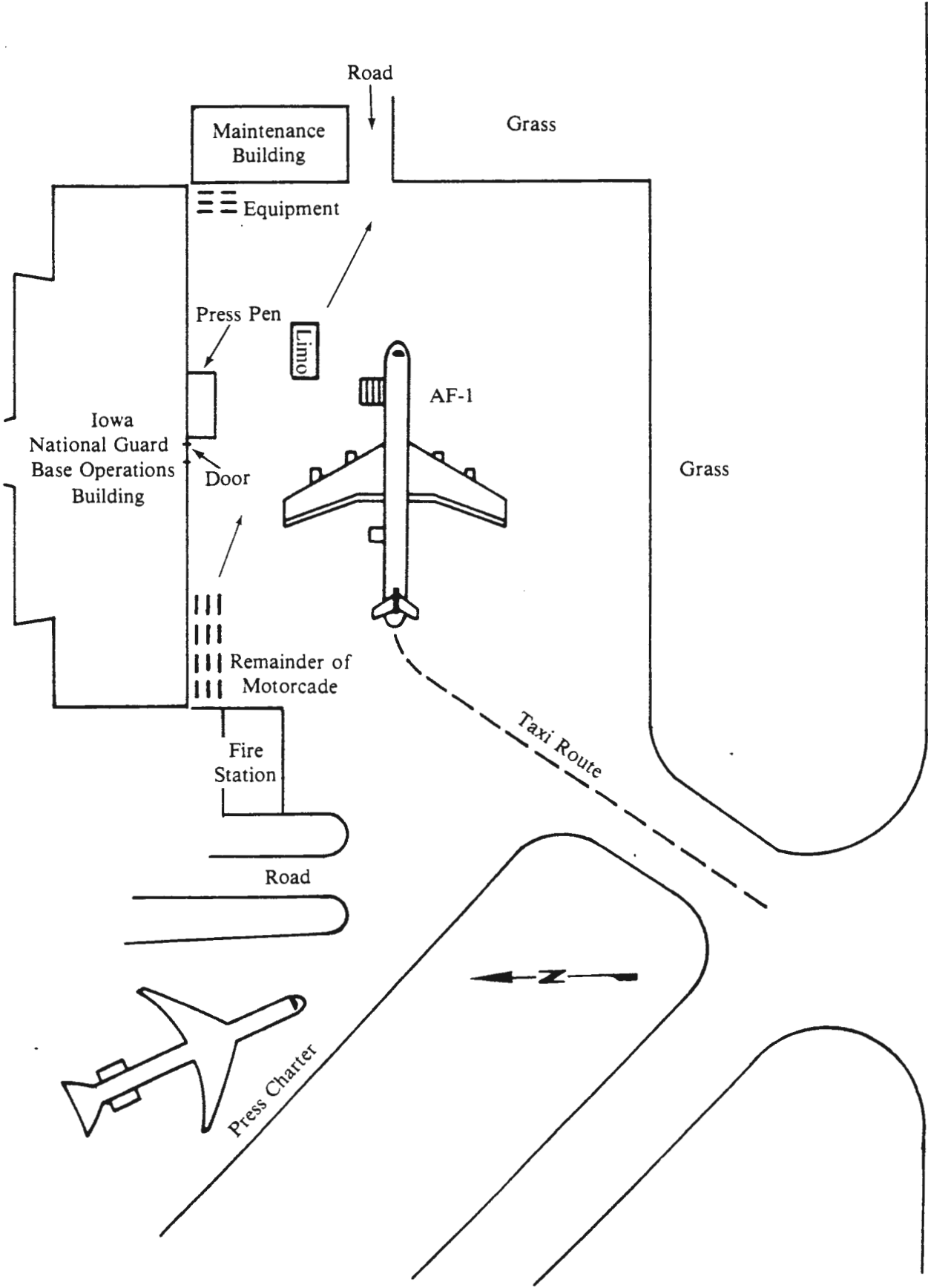

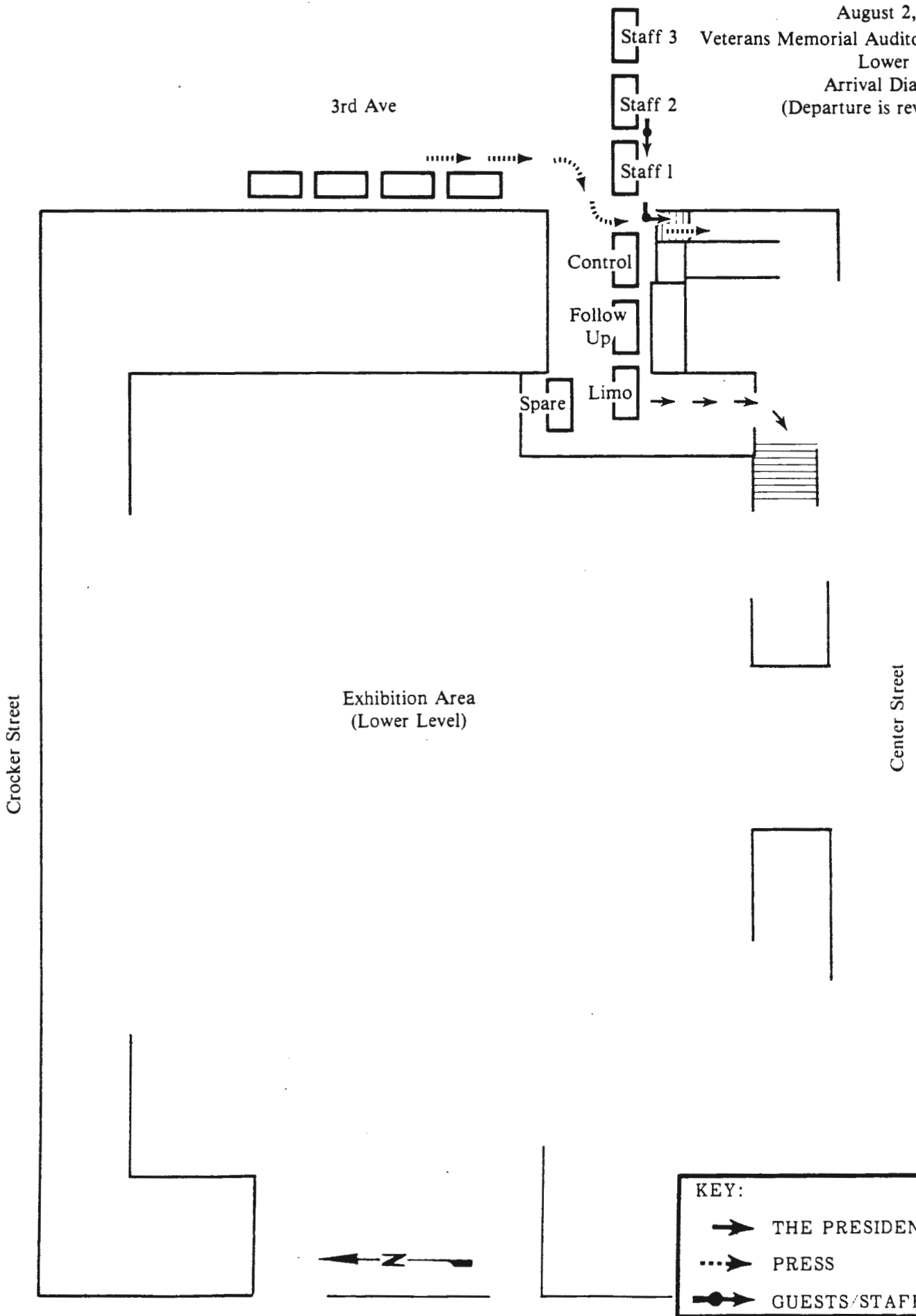

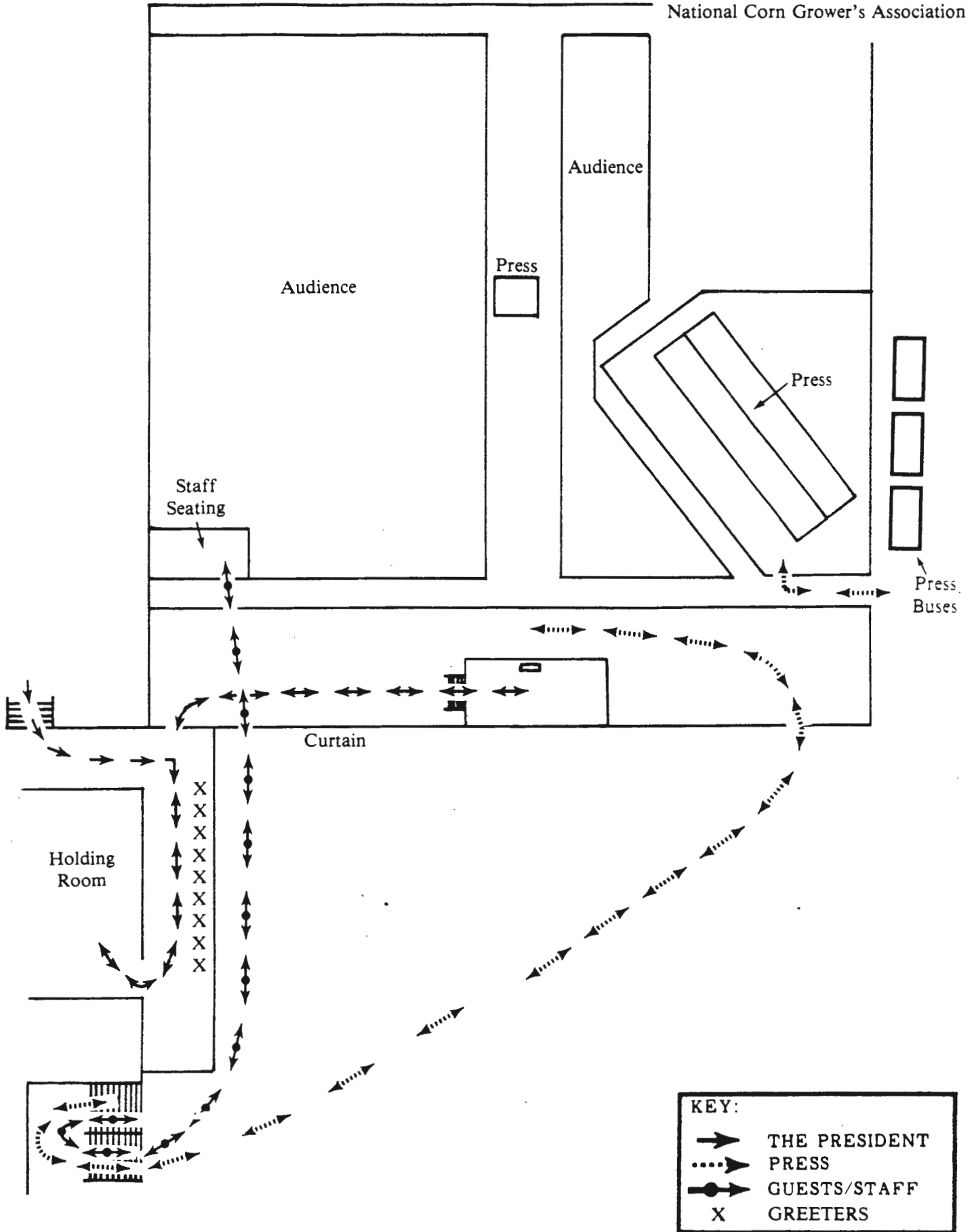

Arrival/Departure Diagram



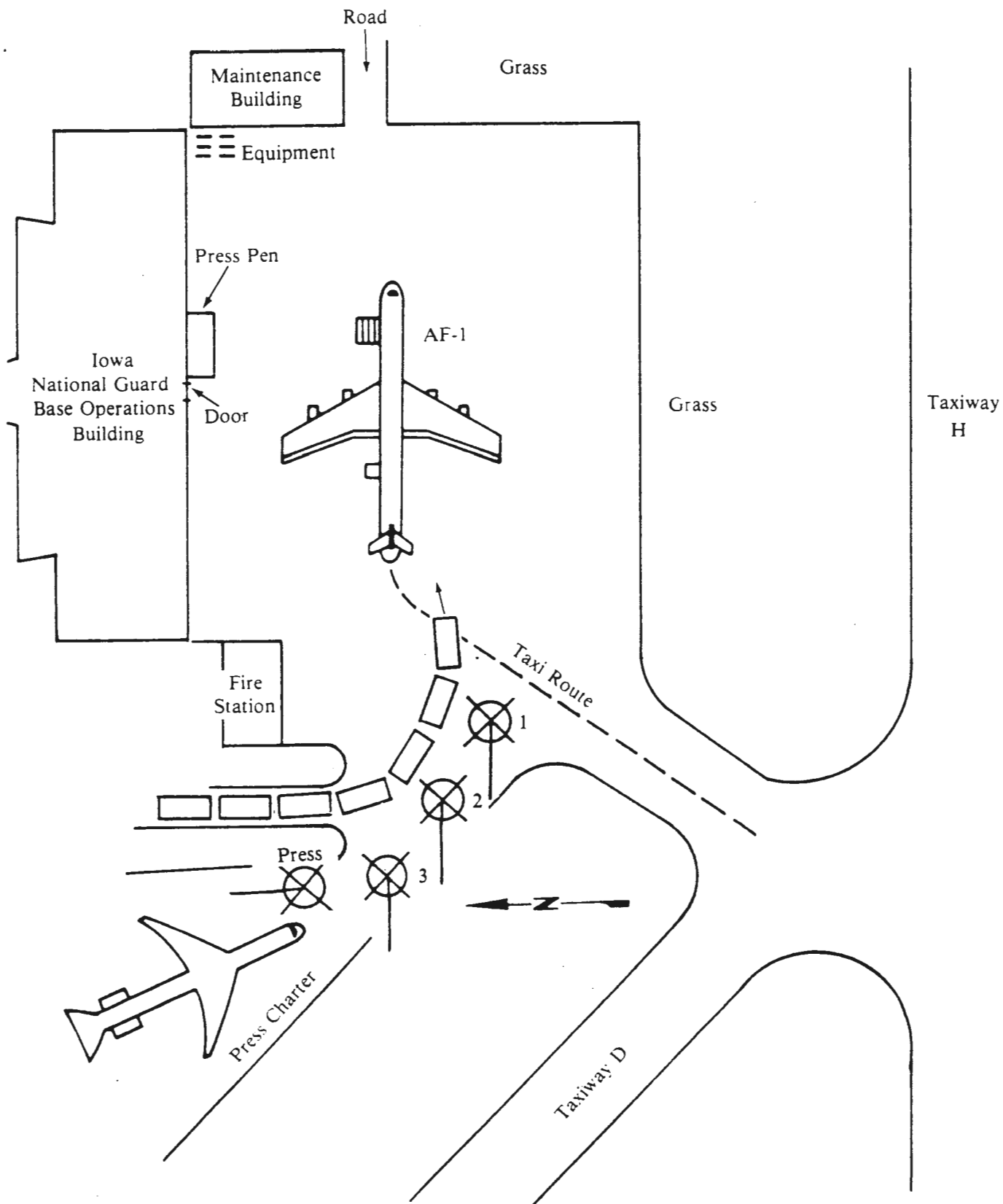




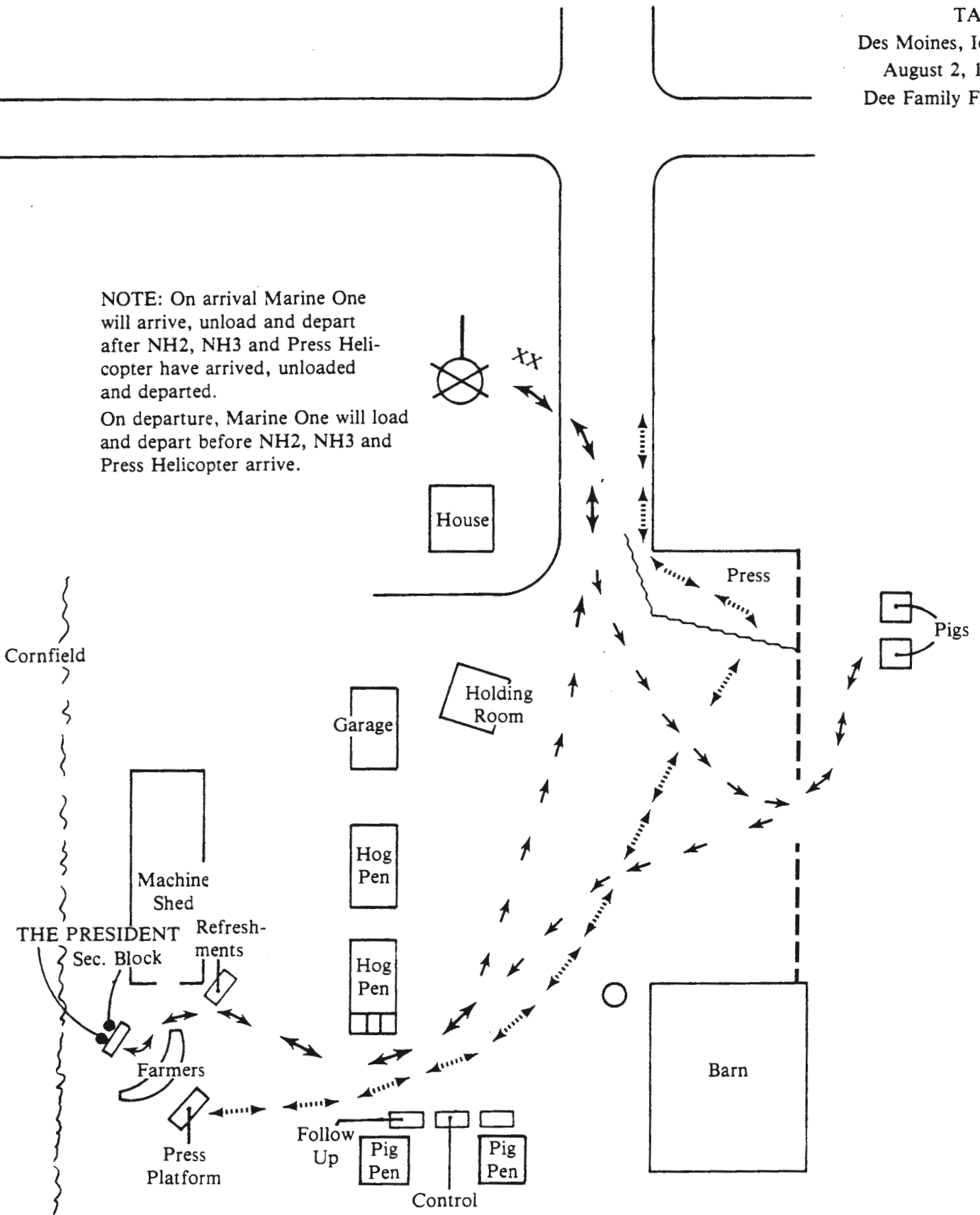

(Farm)



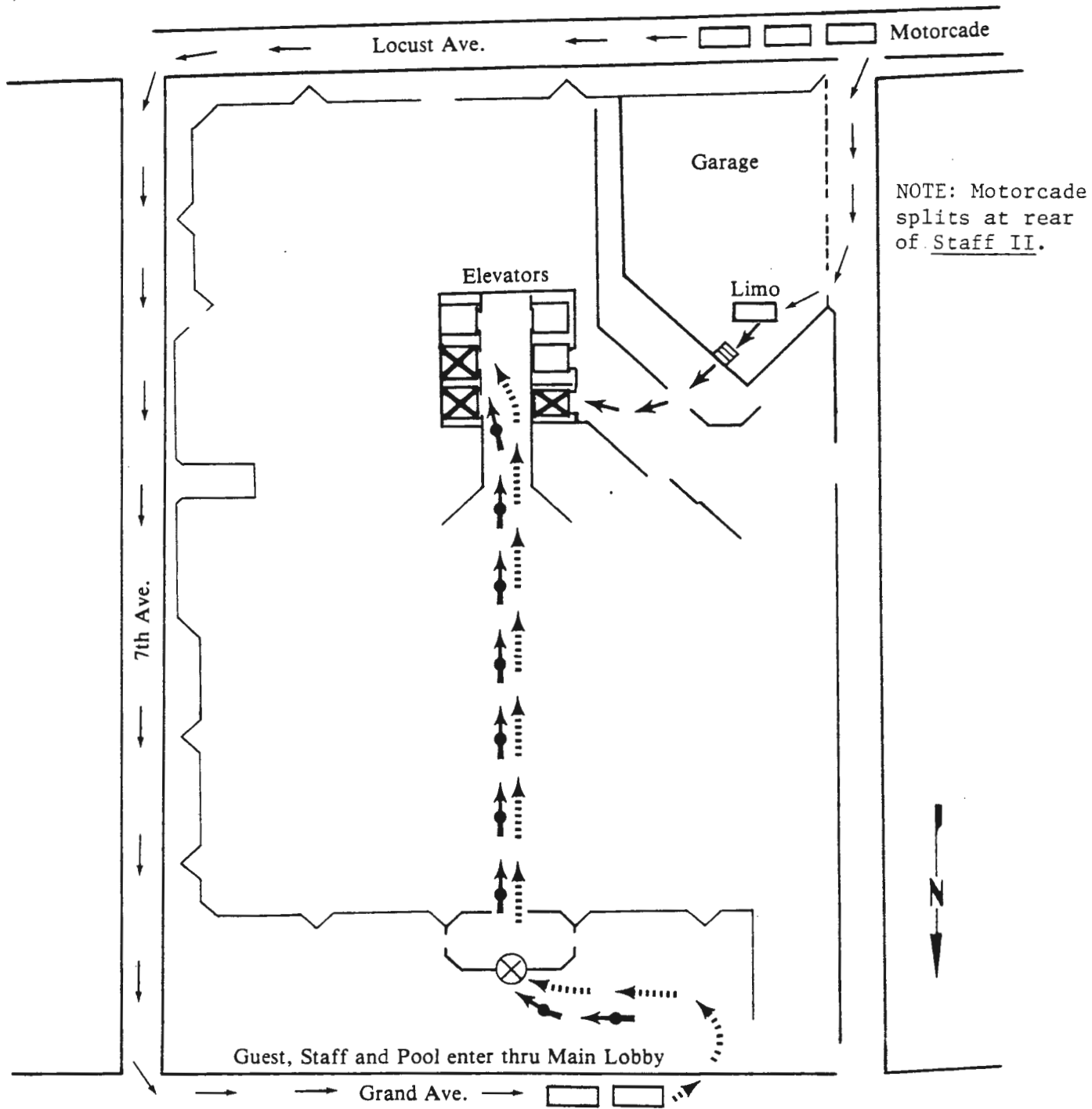

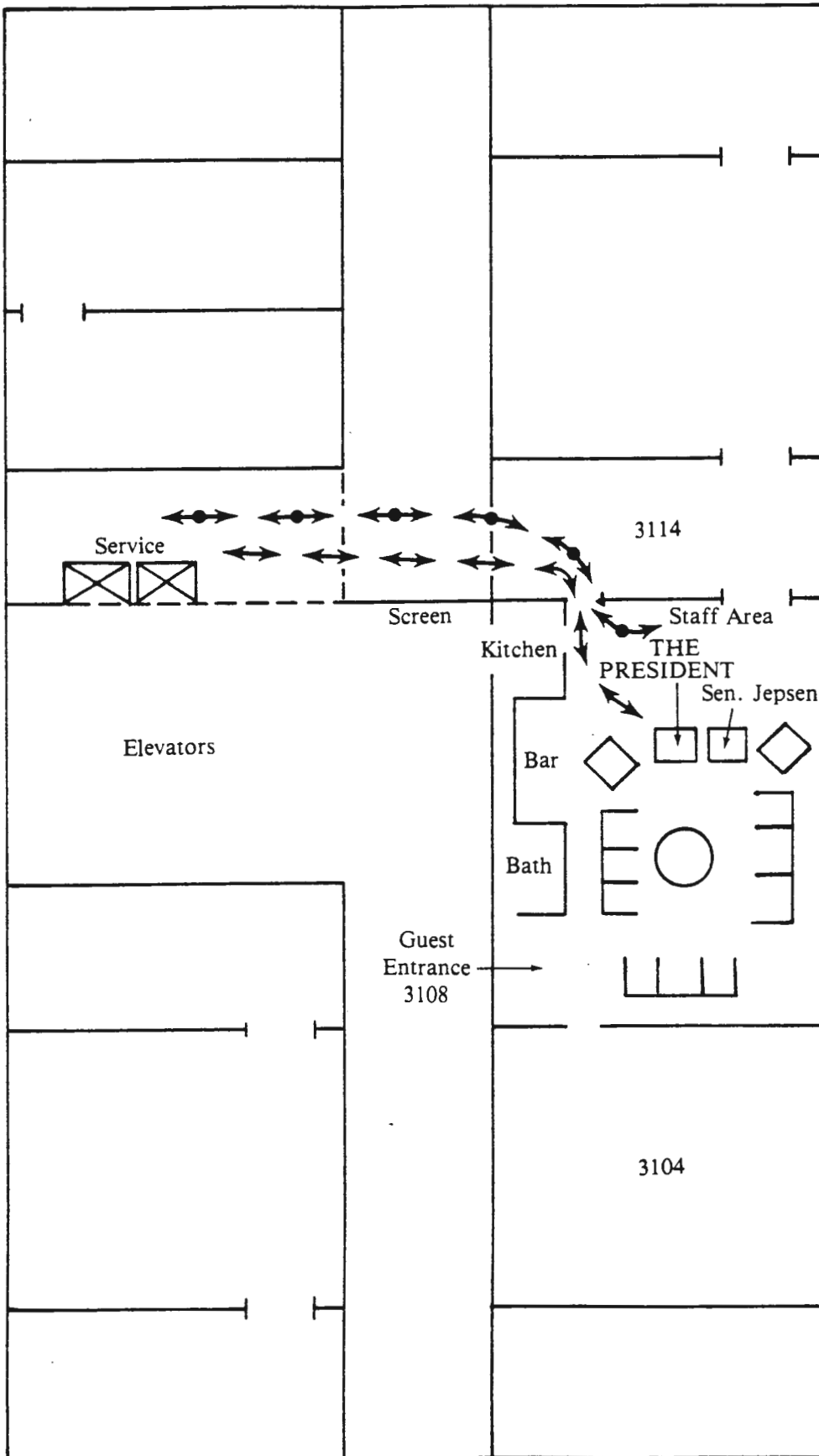

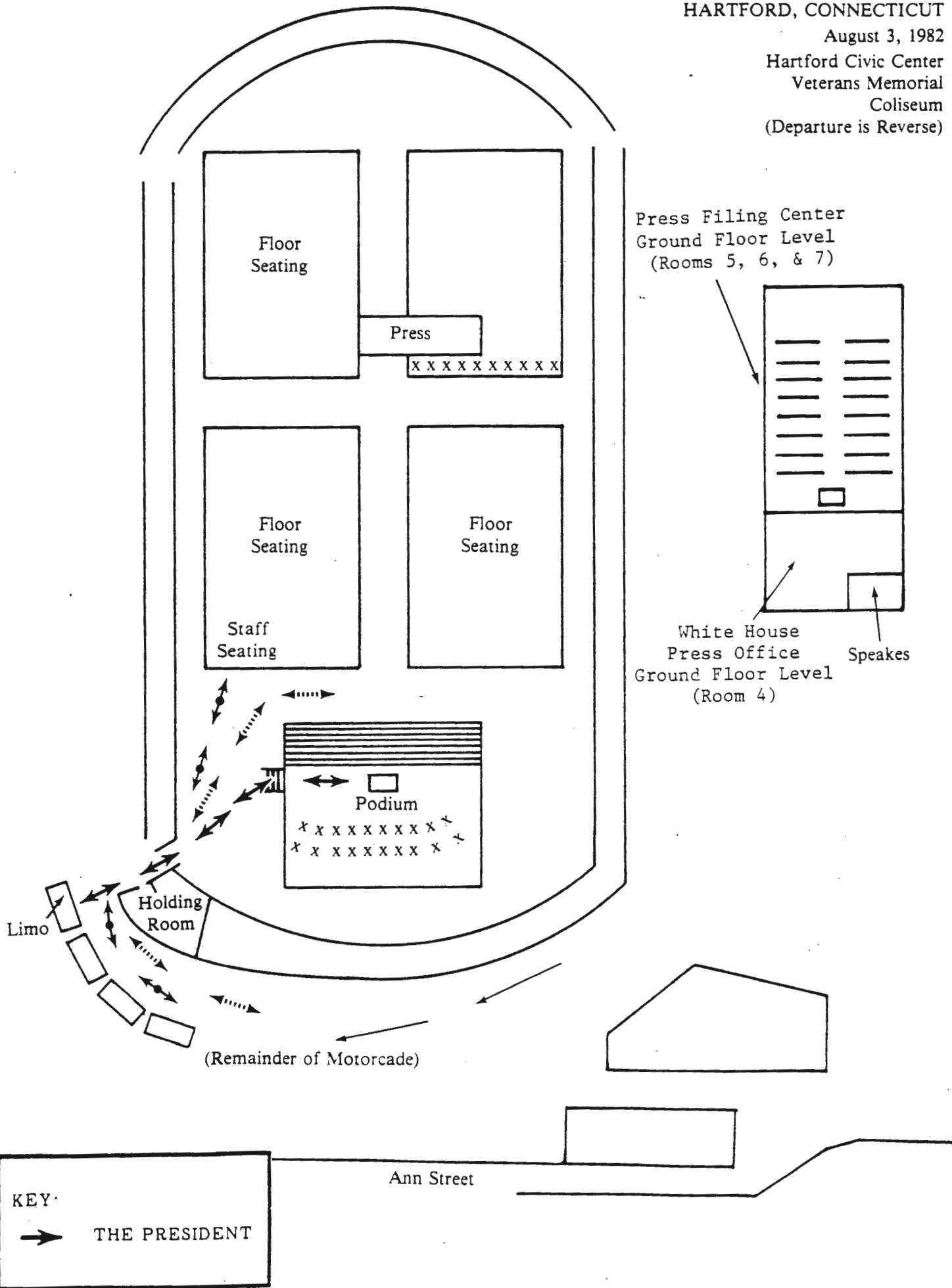
