SUGGESTIONS FOR ITALIAN AMERICAN OUTREACH

- 1. Mailings: Mail press releases and transcripts of White House Press Room statements on appointment of Antonin Scalia to Supreme Court to Italian American media and leadership. (Completed on 6/20.) (LK)

Mailing of photos of RR with Scalia to Italian American media. (CA)

Article by Mari Maseng for Italian American media. (LK)

- 2. Press Conference for Italian-American media: Invite Italian-American media representatives to White House for briefing on domestic and foreign policy issues. Includes briefing by Pat Buchanan. (LK/Media Relations)
- 3. Presidential Briefing for Italian-American leaders: Host White House briefing on domestic and foreign policy issues in Cabinet Room with Presidential drop-by. (LK)
- 4. Vice Presidential Reception for Italian-American leaders: Vice President hosts reception in honor of Judge Scalia for Italian-American leaders at his Residence. Should be coordinated with Presidential briefing. (LK)
- 5. RR, VP address to dinner/reception in honor of Judge Scalia: The National Italian American Foundation (NIAF), the Sons of Italy and the Italian American Bar Association are considering various options of arranging dinners and receptions for Judge Scalia. They would be very pleased to have RR or VP attend and make remarks. (LK)
- 6. Meeting with Italian-American Students: NIAF has sponsored a program to recognize outstanding Italian-American students. NIAF would be happy to coordinate a Washington, D.C. program which would include White House participation. The President could meet with them in the Cabinet Room (as with the Young Ambassadors), or address them in the Rose Garden. This would be continuation of general "youth" theme. (LK)
- 7. Congressional Caucus: The Italian Caucus under the leadership of Chairman Peter Rodino will organize a reception for Judge Scalia on Capitol Hill. Mr. Rodino is one of the deans of the Italian Congressional delegation. Luis has made informal contact with his office. The reception could be a possible VP event. (LK/OLA)
