## **Biography**

### **Brief Biography**

Charlotte De Moss was born on September 17, 1959 in S. Orange, New Jersey. She graduated from Delaware County Christian High School in Newton Square, Pennsylvania. She attended Liberty University for two years and completed her Bachelor of Arts degree at Rosemont College in Rosemont, Pennsylvania in 1982.

In 1982, De Moss worked as an assistant to the president of the Fund for a Conservative Majority in fundraising and working with top donors. She left there to work with Charles Colson's Prison Fellowship Ministries in fundraising. In February 1985, De Moss was a volunteer at the White House working for Carl Anderson managing events and briefings and researching domestic policy issues for speeches and working papers. She was hired in 1986 as a research assistant continuing most of her volunteer assignments. She was technically a detailee at the White House from the Department of Energy. On November 22, 1987, she was appointed to the Office of Policy Development assigned to Gary Bauer's direct staff. De Moss left the White House at the end of the Reagan Administration.

While working at the White House, De Moss continued as one of seven board members of a private family philanthropic foundation, the Arthur S. De Moss Foundation. The Library has little information about De Moss after her work with the Reagan Administration, but we do show her as a continuing officer for the Arthur S. De Moss Foundation, now located in Palm Beach, Florida.

## **Scope and Content Note**

Charlotte De Moss was officially detailed to the White House Office of Public Liaison in February 1986 by the Department of Energy as a Research Assistant to Carl Anderson. She was promoted to Deputy Associate Director in July 1987. She left the Office of Public Liaison (OPL) in November 1987 to join the Office of Policy Development (OPD) staff as a Senior Policy Analyst working for Gary Bauer. It is clear from some of her files that she was doing work for Mr. Bauer as early as November 1, 1987, but her actual start date with OPD was November 22, 1987.

There is more of De Moss OPL work product within the <u>Carl Anderson</u> collection and collections of staff members from the Carl Anderson "group."

De Moss's material from her time at the White House was sent to the Library as part of the OPD office records. Her material was originally transferred in its entirety to the Office of Public Liaison. The Library has since split the material between her two offices. Her interests and responsibilities were in the same subjects throughout her time at the White House, so there is some carry over from earlier material into the OPD material. Folders on the Family Report, fetal experimentation, and labor issues around "homework" continue work begun while De Moss was at Public Liaison.

De Moss's Office of Policy Development collection does not contain series and consists of a single group of subject files arranged in alphabetical order by folder title.
