Dear Mr. President,

On behalf of the U. S. Submarine Veterans WW II, we must protest  
most strongly the Bill before Congress to pay "reparations" to the  
Japanese who were interred in this country during WW II.

This bill must be a real consolation to our survivors of the Bataan  
"Death" March and the rest of our Servicemen who were "interred" in  
Japan. Many of them will never receive \$20, 000 for the injuries and  
disabilities they carry with them to this day.

Let us not lose sight of the fact that EVERYONE'S life was altered  
by that conflict. We had 14 Million Americans in uniform and probably  
75% were interred(drafted) without recourse.

Let the "Do-Gooding" Congressmen contact the Japanese Companies  
selling sophisticated technical machinery to our enemies, TODAY, while  
these same companies are posing as our allies. Maybe they will pay the  
reparations.
